

PULLOVER · FOURSEASON

Design 07 - Filati Classici 18



Size 46/48 (50/52, 54)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 500 (550, 600) g of Lana Grossa **Fourseason** (45% extrafine organic Merino wool, 40% organic cotton, 15% recycled cashmere; 105 m/50 g) in Brown/Orange **(col 21)**. Size 4.5 and 5 mm needles.

Rib patt: P2, k2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Decorative bind-off: * K2, k2tog tbl, sl 3 sts back to left needle; rep from * until 4 sts rem. K2tog 2 times, pass first st over 2nd st. Break yarn and fasten off last st.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

12-st left front neckband: Row 1 (RS): Sl 2 pwise wyib, [p1, sl 1 pwise wyib] 3 times, p2, two-stitch selvage. Row 2 (WS): Two-stitch selvage, k2, [p1, k1] 3 times, p2.

12-st right front neckband: Row 1 (RS): Two-stitch selvage, p2, [sl 1 pwise wyib, p1] 3 times, sl 2 pwise wyib. Row 2 (WS): P2, [k1, p1] 3 times, k2, two-stitch selvage.

Full-fashion decrease 1: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k4, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 7 sts, k2tog, k4, selvage st.

Full-fashion decrease 2: On RS row at right front neck edge, 12-st right front neckband, k4, skp; on RS row at left front neck edge, work to last 18 sts, k2tog, k4, 12-st left front neckband.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 2 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 18 sts and 24 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in St st on size 5 mm needles.

Back: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 100 (108, 116) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, selvage st. Cont in rib patt as established until piece meas 7 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Work decorative bind-off. With RS facing rejoin yarn and with size 5 mm needles pick up and k 100 (108, 116) sts in bind-off row. Sts are picked up between 2nd and 3rd horizontal st of bind-off. Work in St st until piece meas 42 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dec 1, dec 1 st at each end of next 4 RS rows = 82 (90, 98) sts. Work even until armhole meas 23 (24, 25) cm,

ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 4 (4, 5) sts 1 time, then 4 sts 2 times, 3 sts 4 times (then 4 sts 6 times / then 5 sts 3 times, 4 sts 3 times). At same time, when piece meas 3 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 26 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge 1 time.

Front: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 100 (108, 116) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p2, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, selvage st. Cont in rib patt as established until piece meas 7 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Work decorative bind-off. With RS facing rejoin yarn and with size 5 mm needles pick up and k 100 (108, 116) sts in bind-off row. Sts are picked up between 2nd and 3rd horizontal st of bind-off. Work in St st until piece meas 32 (33, 34) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Divide for V-neck: Next row (RS): Selvage st, work 43 (47, 51) sts in St st and turn, leaving rem 56 (60, 64) sts on hold. Left front: Next row (WS): Cast on 12 sts, work to end = 56 (60, 64) sts. Shape V-neck: Working full-fashion dec 2, dec 1 st at end of next RS row, then every 6th row 9 times, then every 4th row 1 time. At same time, when same length as back to armhole, shape armhole at right edge same as for back and when same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back. Work to end of last shoulder bind-off row = 12 sts rem for neckband. Next row (WS): Work to end of row, backloop cast on 1 st (selvage st for seaming) = 13 sts. Work even until neckband meas 10 cm from last shoulder bind-off row. Bind off all sts. Right front: Return 56 (60, 64) held sts to needle and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Complete as given for left front, reversing all shaping.


Sleeves: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 46 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p2, k2; rep from *, end selvage st. Cont in rib patt as established until piece meas 7 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Work decorative bindoff. With RS facing rejoin yarn and with size 5 mm needles pick up and k 100 (108, 116) sts in bind-off row. Sts are picked up between 2nd and 3rd horizontal st of bind-off. Work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 5th row, then every 6th row 13 times (then every 4th row 6 times, then every 6th row 9 times / then every 4th row 12 times, then every 6th row 5 times) = 74 (78, 82) sts. Work even until piece meas 44 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dec 1, dec 1 st at each end of next 12 (11, 10) RS rows. Work 1 WS row. Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 4 (4, 10) rows, 3 sts at beg of next 6 (8, 6) rows. Bind off rem 14 sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew neckbands tog, then sew neckband to back neck edge. Lap right front band over left front band and sew down, sewing through both thicknesses. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

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


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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
