Design 23 – About Berlin Special 03



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 350 (400, 450) g of Lana Grossa Certo (100% GOTS cotton; 115 m/50 g) in Off White (col 11). Size 6 mm needles.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyif, k1, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1. On WS row, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, k1.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

Gauge: 16 sts and 21 rows = 10×10 cm in rev St st on size 6 mm needles.


Front: With size 6 mm needles cast on 85 (91, 97) sts. Next row (WS): * K1, p1; rep from *, end k1. Work in rev St st and shape sides as foll: Dec 1 st at each end of 21st row, then every 10th row 5 times = 73 (79, 85) sts. To dec, p2tog, 1 st in from each edge. Work even until piece meas 39 cm from

cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 3 (4, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows = 67 (71, 75) sts. Working a two-st selvage at each edge and rem sts in rev St st, cont armhole shaping and beg neck shaping: Armhole shaping: Dec 1 st at beg of next 5 (6, 7) RS rows. To dec, p2tog, 2 sts in from edge. At same time, shape neck as foll: Dec 1 st at left edge every row 47 (48, 49) times. To dec at end of RS row, p2tog tbl, 2 sts in from edge; to dec at beg of WS row, skp, 2 sts in from edge and at same time, when 21 (23, 25) sts rem on needle, shape shoulder as foll: At beg of RS rows, bind off 5 sts 3 times (5 sts 1 time, 6 sts 2 times / 6 sts 2 times, 7 sts 1 time). No sts rem.

Back: Work same as front, reversing all shaping and working neck decs as foll: To dec at beg of RS row, p2tog, 2 sts in from edge; to dec at end of WS row, k2tog, 2 sts in from edge.

Belt: With size 4 mm needles cast on 16 sts. Row 1: * SI 1 pwise wyif, k1; rep from * to end. Rep row 1 until piece meas 150 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Sew shoulder and side seams.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
