

PULLOVER · CERTO Design 05 – Sommerideen 01

Size 36 - 40 (42 - 46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 450 (500, 550) g of Lana Grossa **Certo** (100% GOTS cotton; 115 m/50 g) in Olive/Grey Blue/Yellow/Brown/ Natural **(col 105)**. Size 4.5, 5.5 and 9 mm needles; size 4.5 mm circular needle, 50 cm long.

Selvage stitches: On every row: SI first st kwise, k last st.

Garter st: K every row.

St st: K on RS using size 9 mm needle, p on WS using size 4.5 mm needle.

Full-fashion decrease: <u>At beg of RS row</u>, selvage st, skp; <u>at end of RS row</u>, work to last 3 sts, k2tog, selvage st.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 2 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 15 sts and 22 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st, changing needle size every row.

Back: With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 92 (98, 104) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 5 rows and piece meas 1.5 cm from cast-on. Change to size 9 mm needles. Work in St st, change needle size every row, and shape hem with short-rows as foll: Next row (RS): Selvage st, k65 (71, 77), turn. Next row (WS): Yo, k40 (46, 52), turn. Cont in this manner, work 5 additional sts at end of next 4 RS and WS rows, then work 6 additional sts at end of next RS and WS row. Note: Always work each yo tog with next st as k2tog on RS rows, as p2tog tbl on WS rows. Cont in St st across all sts for 16 rows, ending with a WS row. Shape sides: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 18th row 2 times = 86 (92, 98) sts. Work even until piece meas 29 (30, 31) cm, measured along side edge. Place marker at each edge to indicate beg of armholes. Work even until

piece meas 17 (19, 21) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 5 (5, 6) sts 1 time, then 5 sts 2 times, 4 sts 3 times (then 5 sts 5 times / then 6 sts 2 times, 5 sts 3 times). <u>At</u> <u>same time</u>, when piece meas 3 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 22 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge 1 time. No sts rem.

Front: With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 92 (98, 104) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 5 rows and piece meas 1.5 cm from cast-on. Change to size 9 mm needles. Work in St st, change needle size every row, and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of 17th row worked in St st, then every 18th row 2 times = 86(92, 98) sts. Work even until piece meas 29 (30, 31) cm from end of garter st. Place marker at each edge to indicate beg of armholes. Work even until piece meas 17 (19, 21) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 5 (5, 6) sts 1 time, then 5 sts 2 times, 4 sts 3 times (then 5 sts 5 times / then 6 sts 2 times, 5 sts 3 times). At same time, on first row of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Bind off center 16 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 2 times, 1 st 1 time. No sts rem.


Sleeves: With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 41 (47, 53) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 5 rows and piece meas 1.5 cm from cast-on. Change to size 9 mm needles. Work in St st, change needle size every row, and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 9th row worked in St st, then every 10th row 5 times = 53 (59, 65) sts. Work even until piece meas 32 cm from end of garter st. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. <u>Neckband</u>: With size 4.5 mm circular need-le, pick up and k 82 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Purl 2 rnds. Bind off all sts pwise. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.



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




Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **sl** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot St st = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
