

### **JACKET · LACE SETA MULBERRY**

## Design 05 - Tücher & Co. 04



**Size** 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 350 (400, 450) g of Lana Grossa Lace Seta Mulberry (35% Mulberry silk, 35% baby Alpaca, 30% extrafine Merino wool; 175 m/50 g) in Grey Green (col 13). Size 3 and 3.5 mm needles; size 3.5 and 4 mm circular needles, each 80 cm long; size 3 mm crochet hook; nine 15 mm buttons [by UNION KNOPF, item 453708, col 76].

Rib patt: P2, k2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

**Eyelet detail**: Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows; on WS rows purl all sts and yos or work according to chart key. Rep rows 1 – 4.

**Full-fashion decrease**: On RS row, work to 3 sts before eyelet detail, skp, k1, work eyelet detail, k1, k2tog.

**Gauge**: 26 sts and 34 rows =  $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$  in St st on size 4 mm needles.

Back and fronts: Worked in one piece to underarm. With size 3.5 mm circular needle cast on 240 (260, 280) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in St st for 5 rows. Next row (RS): Selvage st, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k2, selvage st. Work in rib patt as established for a total of 11 cm, increasing 20 sts evenly across last WS row = 260 (280, 300) sts. Change to size 4 mm circular needle. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work next 56 (61, 66) sts in St st, work eyelet detail over next 4 sts, work next 20 sts in St st, work eyelet detail over next 4 sts, work next 90 (100, 110) sts in St st, work eyelet detail over next 4 sts, work next 20 sts in St st, work eyelet detail over next 4 sts, work next 56 (61, 66) sts in St st, selvage st. Work in patt as set by last row for 14 cm, ending with a RS row. Next row (WS): Patt over 61 (66, 71) sts, bind off next 20 sts, patt over next 98 (108, 118) sts, bind off next 20 sts, patt to end. Place sts for fronts and back on separate holders.

**Sleeves**: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 54 sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in St st for 5 rows. Next row (RS): Selvage st, k1, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to last 4 sts, p2, k1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as established for a total of 17 cm, increasing 10 (16, 22) sts evenly across last WS row = 64 (70, 76) sts. Change to size 4 mm circular needle. Work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 9th row, then every 10th row 6 times (then every 8th row 8 times / then every alt 6th and 8th row 10 times) = 78 (88, 98) sts. Work even until piece meas 41 (42, 43) cm from cast-on, ending

with a WS row. Bind off 8 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 62 (72, 82) sts. Place sts on holder.


Yoke: Return 61 (66, 71) held right front sts, 62 (72, 82) held sleeve sts, 98 (108, 118) held back sts, 62 (72, 82) held sleeve sts and 61 (66, 71) held left front sts to size 4 mm circular needle = 344 (384, 424) sts and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Work in St st and work eyelet detail as established for 6 (4, 4) rows, ending with a WS row. Working full-fashion dec throughout, shape yoke as foll: For size 36/38: Row 7: Dec 1 st before and after each eyelet detail = 336 sts. Row 8 and all other rows not listed: Work even in patt. Row 13: As row 7 = 328 sts. Row 17: Work decs on fronts and back only = 324 sts. Row 19: Work decs on sleeves only = 320 sts. Row 21: As row 17 = 316 sts. <u>Row 25</u>: As row 7 = 308 sts. <u>Row 29</u>: As row 17 = 304 sts. Row 31: As row 19 = 300 sts. Row 33: As row 17 = 296 sts, then work decs same as on row 7 every 4th row 15 times more = 176 sts. **For size 40/42**: <u>Row 5</u>: Dec 1 st before and after each eyelet detail = 376 sts. Row 6 and all other rows not listed: Work even in patt. Work decs same as on row 5 every 4th row 20 times more = 216 sts. Row 87: Work decs on fronts and back only = 212 sts. Row 89: As row 5 = 204 sts. Row 91: As row 87 = 200 sts, then work decs same as on row 5 every alt row 3 times more = 176 sts. For size 44: Row 5: Dec 1 st before and after each eyelet detail = 416 sts. Row 6 and all other rows not listed: Work even in patt. Work decs same as on row 5 every 4th row 17 times more = 280 sts. Row 75: Work decs on fronts and back only = 276 sts. Row 77: As row 5 = 268 sts. Row 79: As row 75 = 264 sts, then work decs same as on row 5 every alt row 11 times more = 176 sts. For all sizes: Work 1 WS row. Collar: Working eyelet details as established and with 2 sts before and after each eyelet detail as purl sts, work in rib patt for 10 rows. Change to size 3.5 mm needles and cont in patt for 10 more rows. Change to size 3 mm needles and cont in patt for 13 more rows. Work in St st for 4 rows. Bind off all sts kwise.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. Sew sleeve and underarm seams. Buttonhole band: Omitting rolled edges at bottom edge of right front and top edge of collar, with size 3 mm crochet hook and RS facing, work 1 row sc along right front and collar edge. Fasten off. With size 3.5 mm needles and RS facing, pick up and k 152 (156, 160) sts evenly in sc row. Next row (WS): Selvage st, \* p2, k2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p2, selvage st. Work in rib patt as set by last row for a total of 3 rows, ending with a WS row. Next RS (buttonhole) row: With bottom buttonhole in first p2 rib and rem 8 buttonholes spaced approx. 7.5 cm apart, work a total of 9 buttonholes as foll: For each buttonhole, k2tog, yo. Work in rib patt for 5 more rows. Bind off all sts in rib. Buttonband: Omitting rolled edges at top edge of collar and bottom edge of left front, with size 3 mm crochet hook and RS facing, work 1 row sc along collar and left front edge. Fasten off. Complete as given for buttonhole band, omitting buttonholes.

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

oo = on RS, yo twice; on WS, p1f&b into dbl yo






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## Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
