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PULLOVER · CASHMERE PURO
Design 02 – Cashmere Special 01

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 425 (450, 475, 500) g of Lana Grossa **Cashmere Puro** (100% cashmere; 82 m/25 g) in Beige (col 4). Size 4 and 5 mm needles; size 4 mm circular needle, 40 cm long; cable needle [cn].

Rib patt: P2, k2.

Seed stitch: Even number of sts. **Row 1:** Selvage st, * k1, p1; rep from *, end selvage st. **Row 2:** Selvage st, purl the knit sts and knit the purl sts, selvage st. Rep row 2 for seed st.

12-st cable: Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows; on WS rows, work sts as they appear. Rep rows 1 – 10.

Gauge: 19 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in seed st on size 5 mm needles; 12-st cable = 4.5 cm wide.

Back: With size 4 mm needles cast on 110 (118, 126, 134) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as established until piece meas 9 cm from cast-on, increasing 2 sts across last WS row = 112 (120, 128, 136) sts. Change to size 5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 10 (14, 18, 22) sts in seed st, [12-st cable, 14 sts in seed st] 3 times, 12-st cable, 10 (14, 18, 22) sts in seed st, selvage st. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 48 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 (2, 4, 4) rows, 1 st at beg of next 2 (6, 6, 10) rows = 92 (96, 100, 104) sts. Cont in patt until piece meas 65 (66, 67, 68) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 24 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge 3 times, 3 sts 1 time and when piece meas 3 cm from beg of neck shaping, bind off rem 19 (21, 23, 25) sts for each shoulder.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 40 (41, 42, 43) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape V-neck: Next row (RS): Divide work at center. Working each side separately, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 19 times, then every alt RS row 8 times. **At same time**, when same length as back to armholes, shape armholes as foll: At each armhole edge, bind off 4 sts 1 time, 3 sts 1 time, 2 sts 1 (1, 2, 2) time(s), 1 st 1 (3, 3, 5) times and when same length as back to shoulders, bind off rem 19 (21, 23, 25) sts for each shoulder.

Sleeves: With size 4 mm needles cast on 54 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as established until piece meas 11 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 7 sts in seed st, 12-st cable, 14 sts in seed st, 12-st cable, 7 sts in seed st, selvage st. Work in patt as set by last row and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 9 (7, 7, 7)th row after rib patt, then every 8th row 4 times, then every 6th row 6 times (then every 6th row 12 times / then every 6th row 8 times, then every 4th row 6 times / then every 6th row 4 times, then every 4th row 12 times) = 76 (80, 84, 88) sts. Work increased sts into seed st. Cont in patt until piece meas 40 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 3 (3, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 (4, 4, 6) rows, 1 st at beg of next 30 (30, 32, 32) rows, 2 sts at beg of next 4 (4, 4, 4) rows, 3 sts at beg of next 4 (4, 4, 4) rows. Bind off rem 16 sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. **Neckband:** With size 4 mm circular needle, beg and end at bottom of front center V, pick up and k 160 sts evenly along neck edge. Work back and forth in rows: Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p2, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, selvage st. Work in rib patt as established until band meas 4 cm from pick-up row. Bind off all sts in rib. Lap right front neckband over left front neckband at bottom of front center V and sew down. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

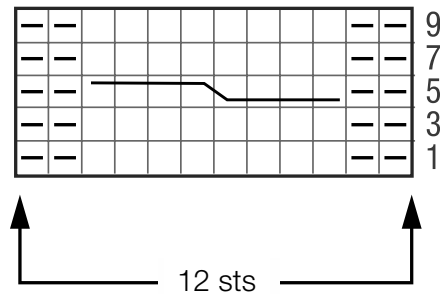
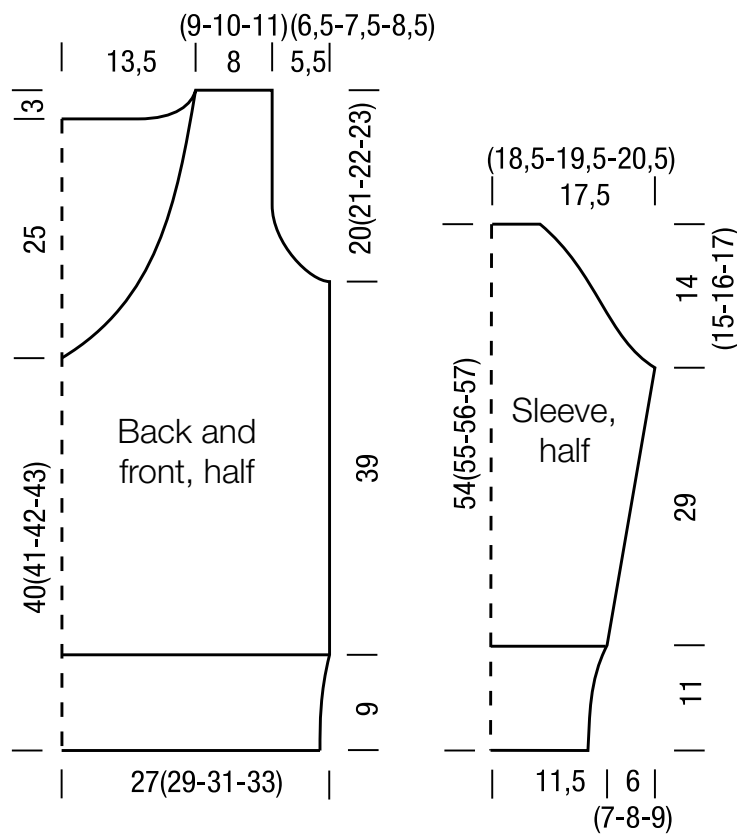


Chart key:

- = sl 4 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k4, then k4 from cn



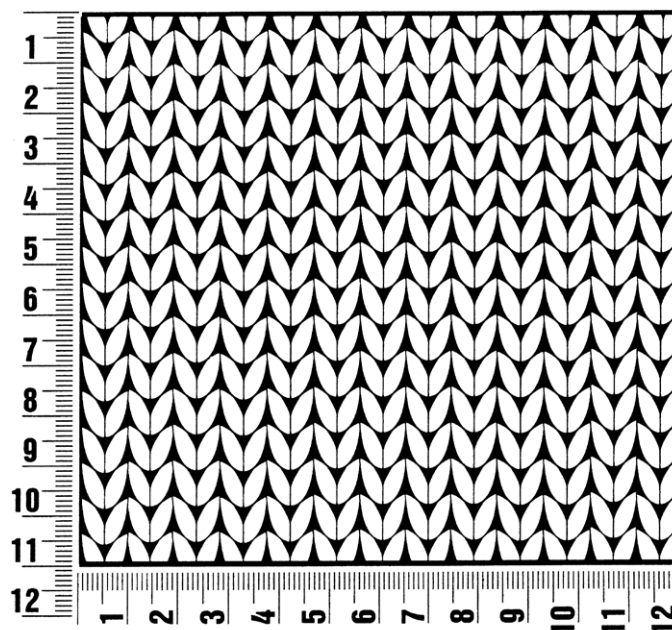
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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
