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JACKET · CASHMERE PURO

Design 14 – Cashmere Special 01

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Size 36/38 (40/42)

Instructions are given for smaller size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

Materials: 275 (300) g of Lana Grossa **Cashmere Puro** (100% cashmere; 82 m/25 g) in Salmon (col 8). Size 4.5 and 5 mm needles; two 23 mm buttons [by UNION KNOFF, item 37604, col 12].

Rib patt: P2, k2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

Welt patt: 2 rows in St st, 2 rows in rev St st = 4 rows. Rep these 4 rows throughout for welt patt.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, p2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 3 sts, p2tog tbl, selvage st.

Gauge: 17 sts and 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm in welt patt on size 5 mm needles.

Back: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 70 (78) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as established until piece meas 5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Work in welt patt, decreasing 0 (2) sts across row = 70 (76) sts. Cont in welt patt and shape sides as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 9th row worked in welt patt, then every 8th row 3 times = 78 (84) sts. Work even until piece meas approx. 18 cm from cast-on, ending with 2 rows in St st. Shape raglan: Bind off 2 (3) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work 2 rows even. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every alt RS row 23 (25) times = 26 sts and when piece meas 50 (52) cm from cast-on, bind off all sts.

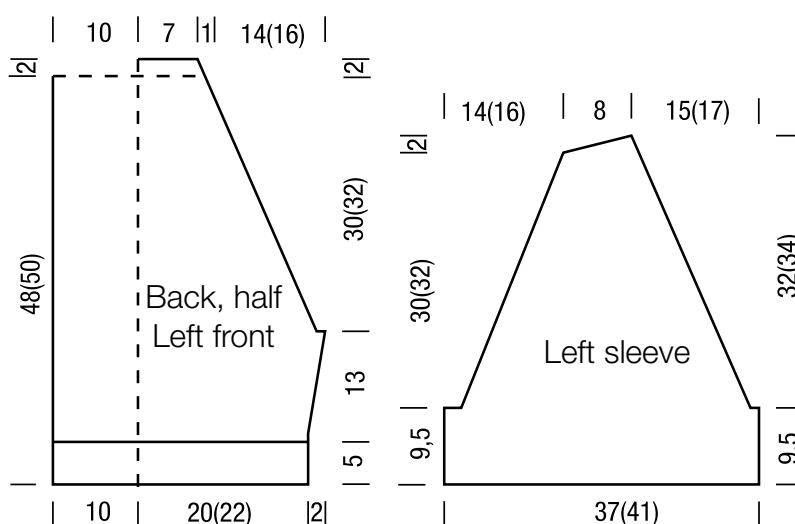
Left front: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 52 (56) sts. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, p2, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as established until piece meas 5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 5 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in welt patt, work incs for side shaping at right edge same as for back = 56 (60) sts. Work even until piece meas approx. 18 cm from cast-on, ending with 2 rows in St st. Shape raglan: Bind off 2 (3) sts at beg of next RS row. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at beg of every alt RS row 22 (24) times = 32 (33) sts and when piece meas 48 (50) cm from cast-on, place sts on holder.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement and working 2 buttonholes at beg of RS rows as foll: Two-stitch selvage, p3, [p2tog, yo] for buttonhole, work to end. Work first buttonhole on 19th row worked in welt patt and 2nd buttonhole spaced 20 rows apart.

Left sleeve: With size 5 mm needles cast on 65 (71) sts. Purl 1 WS row, work in rev St st for 2 rows. Work in welt patt until piece meas approx. 9.5 cm from cast-on, ending with 2 rows in St st. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 2 (3) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work 2 rows even. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every alt RS row 21 (23) times = 17 sts. Next row (WS): Bind off 5 sts, work to end. Next row (RS): Dec 1 st at beg of row only, work to end. Rep last 2 rows once more. Bind off rem 5 sts.

Right sleeve: Work same as left sleeve, reversing cap shaping.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams. **Left half of collar:** Return 48 (50) held left front sts to size 5 mm needles and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Maintaining two-stitch selvage at front edge, work in welt patt for 15 cm. Bind off all sts. Rep for right half of collar. With mattress st, sew bound-off edges of collar halves tog, sewing top 11 cm from WS for the turnback of the collar to RS. Sew collar to back neck edge and top edge of sleeves. Sew on buttons.



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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
