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JACKET · CASHMERE PURO

Design 15 – Cashmere Special 01

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 325 (350, 375, 400) g of Lana Grossa **Cashmere Puro** (100% cashmere; 82 m/25 g) in Dark Green (col 15). Size 4.5 and 5 mm needles.

Garter st: K every row.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Selvage sts: On RS row, ktbl first st, sl last st pwise wyib; on WS row, ptbl first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Gauge: 19 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 5 mm needles.

Right half of back: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 62 (66, 70, 74) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 5 rows. Change to size 5 mm needles. Working first and last st as selvage sts, work in St st until piece meas 34 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve: At beg of RS rows, cast on 2 sts 2 times, 9 sts 6 times (2 sts 3 times, 7 sts 1 time, 9 sts 5 times / 2 sts 4 times, 5 sts 1 time, 9 sts 5 times / 2 sts 5 times, 3 sts 1 time, 9 sts 5 times = 120 (124, 128, 132) sts. Maintaining selvage sts, work even for 10 cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work in St st to last 26 sts, work in garter st over next 25 sts, selvage st. Work in patt as set by last row for 5 more rows, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage st, k95 (99, 103, 107) and place these 96 (100, 104, 108) sts on holder, bind off rem 24 sts.

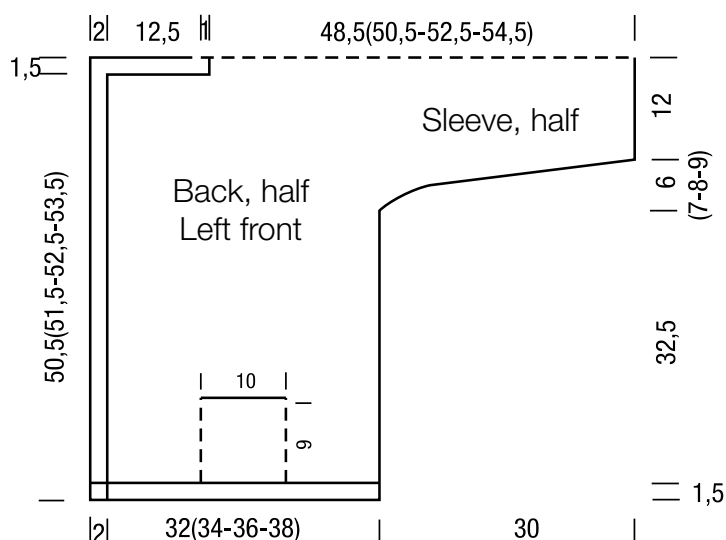
Left half of back: Work same as right half, reversing all shaping.

Pocket lining: Make 2. With size 5 mm needles cast on 20 sts. Work in St st for 9 cm, ending with a RS row. Place sts on holder, cut yarn.

Left front: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 66 (70, 74, 78) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 5 rows. Change to size 5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work next 60 (64, 68, 72) sts in St st, work next 5 sts in garter st. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 9 cm from end of garter st, ending with a WS row. Next RS (pocket opening) row: Work first 22 (24, 26, 28) sts, bind off 20 sts for pocket opening, patt to end. Next row (WS): Patt to bound-off sts, with WS of pocket lining facing, p20 of lining, patt to end. Cont in patt across all sts until piece meas 34 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve: At beg of RS rows, cast on 2 sts 2 times, 9 sts 6 times (2 sts 3 times, 7 sts 1 time, 9 sts 5 times / 2 sts 4 times, 5 sts 1 time, 9 sts 5 times / 2 sts 5 times, 3 sts 1 time, 9 sts 5 times = 124 (128, 132, 136) sts. Work even for 10 cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage, work in St st to last 30 sts, work in garter st to end. Work in patt as set by last row for 5 more rows, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage st, k95 (99, 103, 107) and place these 96 (100, 104, 108) sts on holder, bind off rem 28 sts.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. With mattress st and from WS (so seam forms a ridge on RS), sew back halves tog. Graft shoulder/overarms tog. Sew pocket linings in place on WS. Sew side and sleeve seams.



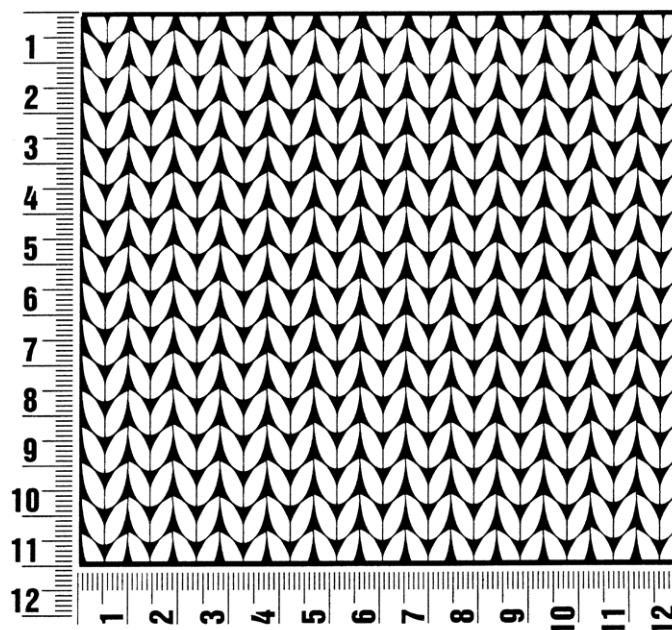
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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
