

# PULLOVER · ALTA MODA COTOLANA PRINT & ALESSIA

# Design 17 – Lookbook 10



**Size** 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 350 (400, 400, 450) g of Lana Grossa Alta Moda Cotolana Print (45% Merino wool, 45% Pima cotton, 10% polyamide; 200 m/100 g) in Dark Olive/Olive/Grey Green/Burgundy/Salmon (col 102) and 300 (350, 350, 400) g of Lana Grossa Alessia (76% cotton, 20% recycled polyester, 4% polyester; 135 m/50 g) in Charcoal/Grey/Natural (col 5). Size 4.5 mm circular needle, 100 cm long; size 4.5 mm crochet hook.

Garter st: K every row.


St st: K on RS, p on WS.

**Gauges**: On size 4.5 mm needles: 22 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st with Alessia; 22 sts and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st with Alta Moda Cotolana Print.

**Pullver**: Pullover is worked in one piece and side to side, starting at left sleeve, Arrow on schematic shows direction of work. Join in and break off yarns as required. With size 4.5 mm circular needle and Alta Moda Cotolana Print cast on 106 (110, 114, 118) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 5 rows. Work in St st until piece meas 40 (39, 38, 37) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. With Alessia, cast on 105 (103, 101, 99) sts, work in St st across 106 (110, 114, 118) on needle, cast on 105 (103, 101, 99) sts, = 316 sts. Working first and last 4 sts in garter st and rem sts in St st, work even until a total of 15 (16, 17, 18) cm has been worked with Alessia. With Alta

Moda Cotolana Print work even for 5 (6, 7, 8) cm, ending with a WS row. Divide for back and front: Next row (RS): Work across first 158 sts and turn, leaving rem 158 sts on hold. Back: Cont across 158 back sts only and shape neck as foll: Bind off 1 st at beg of next 4 WS rows = 154 sts. Work even until piece meas 10 cm from divide, ending with a WS row and center of back has been reached. With Alessia, work 2nd half of back neck same as first half, reversing shaping = 158 sts. End with a RS row. Place sts on holder, cut yarn. Front: Return 158 held front sts to needle and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Shape neck: At beg of RS rows, bind off 3 sts 1 time, 1 st 7 times = 148 sts. Work even until piece meas 10 cm from divide, ending with a WS row and center of front has been reached. With Alessia, work 2nd half of front neck same as first half, reversing shaping = 158 sts. End with a RS row. Next WS (joining) row: Work across 158 front sts and 158 back sts on holder = 316 sts. Work even until piece meas 5 (6, 7, 8) cm from joining row, ending with a WS row. With Alta Moda Cotolana Print, work even for 15 (16, 17, 18) cm, ending with a WS row. Bind off 105 (103, 101, 99) sts at beg of next 2 rows = 106 (110, 114, 118) sts. With Alessia, work even for 38.5 (37.5, 36.5, 35.5) cm, ending with a RS row. Beg and end with a WS row, work in garter st for 5 rows. Bind off all sts.

**Finishing**: Pin piece to measurements and block. Neck edging: with size 4.5 mm crochet hook and Alta Moda Cotolana Print, work 1 rnd of 110 sc around neck edge. Fasten off. With size 4.5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 1 st in each sc = 110 sts. Bind off as foll: \* K2, k2tog tbl, pass 3 sts back to left needle; rep from \* until 4 sts rem. K2tog 2 times. Pass first st over 2nd st. Break yarn and fasten off last st. Sew side and sleeve seams.





## Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

**beg** = begin(ning)  $\cdot$  **ch** = chain  $\cdot$  **cont** = continue  $\cdot$  **dec** = decreas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **inc** = increas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **k** = knit  $\cdot$  **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures  $\cdot$  **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop  $\cdot$  **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop  $\cdot$  **patt** = pattern  $\cdot$  **pm** = place marker  $\cdot$  **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl  $\cdot$  **rem** = remain(ing)  $\cdot$  **rep** = repeat(s)  $\cdot$  **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **rnd(s)** = round(s)  $\cdot$  **RS** = right side  $\cdot$  **sc** = single crochet  $\cdot$  **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s1** = slip  $\cdot$  **st(s)** = stitch(es)  $\cdot$  **St st** = stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **tbl** = through the back loop  $\cdot$  **tog** = together  $\cdot$  **wyib** = with yarn in back of work  $\cdot$  **wyif** = with yarn in front of work  $\cdot$  **WS** = wrong side  $\cdot$  **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
