JACKET · ABOUT BERLIN BULKY PRINT & ABOUT BERLIN BULKY Design 18 – Lookbook 10



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 350 (400, 450) g each of Lana Grossa **About Berlin Bulky Print** (50% cotton, 50% Micromodal; 47 m/50 g) in White/Pistachio/Orange/Jade/Light Petrol (col 153) and Lana Grossa **About Berlin Bulky** (50% cotton, 50% Micromodal; 47 m/50 g) in Beige (col 13). Size 10 and 12 mm circular needle, each 60 cm long; size 9 mm crochet hook.

Main patt: Row 1 (WS) with Bulky: Selvage st, purl all sts tbl, end selvage st. SI sts to other end of needle. Row 2 (WS) with Bulky Print: Selvage st, purl all sts tbl, end selvage st. Turn work. Row 3 (RS) with Bulky: Selvage st, knit all sts tbl, end selvage st. SI sts to other end of needle. Row 4 (RS) with Bulky Print: Selvage st, knit all sts tbl, end selvage st. Turn work. Rep rows 1 – 4 for main patt.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Full-fashion decrease: <u>At beg of RS row</u>, selvage st, k4tbl, skp; <u>at end of RS row</u>, work to last 7 sts, k2tog tbl, k4tbl, selvage st. <u>At beg of WS row</u>, selvage st, p4tbl, p2tog tbl; <u>at end of WS row</u>, work to last 7 sts, p2tog tbl, p4tbl, selvage st.

Full-fashion increase: <u>On RS row</u>: M1, 2 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 9 sts and 11 rows = 10×10 cm in main patt on size 12 mm needles.

Back: With size 10 mm circular needle and Bulky Print cast on 45 (49, 53) sts. Work in main patt for 4 rows. Change to size 12 mm circular needle. Cont in main patt and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 10th row from cast-on, then every 6th row 4 times = 55 (59, 63) sts. Cont in main patt until piece meas 50 (51, 52) cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.


Left front: With size 10 mm circular needle and Bulky Print cast on 24 (26, 28) sts. Work in main patt for 4 rows. Change to size 12 mm circular needle. Cont in main patt, work incs for side shaping at right edge same as for back. <u>At same time</u>, when working 2nd side shaping inc (a RS row with Bulky Print) and piece meas approx. 14 cm from cast-on, work pocket lining as foll: Place first 6 (7, 8) sts (includes increased st) on holder, place last 8 (9, 10) sts on 2nd holder = 12 sts rem for pocket lining. Work in St st across pocket lining sts for 20 cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Work main patt across 6 (7, 8) sts on 12 pocket lining sts and across 8 (9, 10) sts on 2nd holder = 24 (26, 28) sts. Cont in

main patt across all sts and when piece meas 20 (21, 22) cm from cast-on, shape neck as foll: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at end of next RS row, then every 6th row 5 times = 23 (25, 27) sts after side and neck shaping is complete. Work even until piece meas 50 (51, 52) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Bind off 17 (19, 21) sts at beg of next RS row, work to end of row = 6 sts rem for neckband. Cont across neckband sts for 6 cm. Bind off all sts.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping.

Sleeves: With size 10 mm circular needle and Bulky Print cast on 19 sts. Work in main patt for 2 rows. Next inc row: Selvage st, k1tbl, [M1R, k3tbl] 6 times, k1tbl, selvage st = 6 sts increased and 25 sts total. Mark increased sts. Cont in main patt, rep inc row every alt row 2 more times = 37 sts. Always work incs at markers; on WS inc row, work M1L inc. At same time, after having worked a total of 4 rows from cast-on, change to size 12 mm circular needle. Cont in main patt and working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of every alt row 0 (1, 2) time(s) = 37 (39, 41) sts. Work even until piece meas 42 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew bound-off edges of neckbands tog, then sew neckband to back neck edge. Sew pocket linings in place on WS. Place markers 19 (20, 21) cm down from shoulders on fronts and back. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. With size 9 mm crochet hook and Bulky Print, sl st along right front, top edge of neckband and left front edge. Work sl st 1 st in from edge.






Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **sl** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot St st = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
