

PULLOVER · GOMITOLO PAZZO

Design 01 – Gomitolo 07



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 (400, 500) g of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Pazzo** (52% cotton, 48% acrylic; 260 m/100 g) in Pink/Yellow/White/ Ice Blue Variegated **(col 816)**. Size 3.5 and 4.5 mm needles; one set size 3.5 mm double-pointed needles [dpns].

Rib patt: P2, k2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.


Gauge: 20 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 4.5 mm needles.

Back: With size 3.5 mm circular needle cast on 110 (118, 126) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st (p on WS, k on RS), p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st (p on WS, k on RS). Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 4.5 mm circular needle. Work in St st until piece meas 48 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeves: Cast on 10 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 130 (138, 146) sts. Work even until sleeve meas 10 (11, 12) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape

shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 11 (12, 13) sts 1 time, then 11 sts 2 times, 10 sts 1 time (then 12 sts 2 times, 11 sts 1 time / then 13 sts 2 times, 12 sts 1 time). At same time, on 2nd RS shoulder bind-off row, work neck as foll: Bind off center 42 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 1 st at each neck edge 1 time. No sts rem.

Front: Work same as back.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Front neckband: With size 3.5 mm circular needle and RS facing, pick up and k 132 (140, 148) sts evenly along left shoulder/overarm, neck and right shoulder/overarm edge. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * p2, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, selvage st. Cont in rib patt as set by last row until band meas 7 cm. Bind off all sts in rib. Fold band in half to WS and sew down. Back neckband: Beg at right shoulder/overam and end at left shoulder/overarm, pick up and k 132 (140, 148) sts evenly along top edge of back. Work same as for front neckband. Join front and back neckband over 3 sts at beg of neck shaping, at outer edge of shoulders/overarms and 8 (9, 10) cm in from outer edge of shoulders/overarms. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sleeve bands: With size 3.5 mm dpns, pick up and k 68 (76, 84) sts evenly around sleeve edge. Arrange sts evenly on 4 needles = 17 (19, 21) sts per needle, place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work rib patt in rnds for 6 cm. Bind off all sts in rib.





Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
