

PULLOVER · GOMITOLO DENIM GRAFFITI Design 10 – Gomitolo 07

MODE WOLLE

Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 (400, 600) g of Lana Grossa Gomitolo Denim Graffiti (80% cotton 20% polyamide; 740 m/200 g) in Green/Orange/Fuchsia/Turquoise/Olive (col 352). Size 4 mm needles; size 3.5 mm circular needle, 40 cm long; size 3.5 mm crochet hook.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Drop stitch patt: <u>Rows 1 and 2</u>: Knit. <u>Row 3</u>: Selvage st, * yo, k1; rep from *, end selvage st. <u>Row 4</u>: Knit all sts, drop all yos.

Main patt: 8 rows St st, 4 rows drop st patt = 12 rows. Rep these 12 rows for main patt throughout.

Full-fashion decrease: <u>At beg of RS row</u>, selvage st, skp; <u>at end of RS row</u>, work to last 3 sts, k2tog, selvage st.


Gauges: On size 4 mm needles: 23 sts and 31 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in main patt; 23 sts and 35 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in St st.

Back: With size 4 mm needles cast on 108 (116, 126) sts. Knit 1 WS row. Work rows 3 and 4 of drop st patt. Work main patt for 84 rows (= 7 rows reps) and piece meas 28 cm from cast-on. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 13 (10, 2) times, then every alt row 22 (29, 42) times. <u>At same</u> <u>time</u>, when 48 rows (= 4 row reps) have been worked from beg of raglan shaping, work remainder of back in St st and when piece meas 53 (54, 55) cm from cast-on, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 34 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 1 st at each neck edge 1 time. No sts rem.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 50 (51, 52) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 12 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 3 sts 1 time, 2 sts 1 time, 1 st 3 times.

Sleeves: With size 4 mm needles cast on 84 sts. Knit 1 WS row. Work rows 3 and 4 of drop st patt. Work main patt and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 0 (1, 1) st at each end of -- (11, 7)th row, then every 0 row 0 times (then every 8th row 4 times / then every alt 4th and 6th row 5 times, then every 4th row 4 times) = 84 (94, 104) sts. Work even until main patt has been worked for 48 rows (= 4 rows reps) and piece meas 16 cm from cast-on. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 17 (12, 6) times, then every alt row 16 (26, 37) times. <u>At same time</u>, when 48 rows (= 4 row reps) have been worked from beg of cap shaping, work remainder of sleeve in St st and when piece meas 42 (43, 44) cm from cast-on, bind off rem 16 sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams. <u>Neckband</u>: With size 3.5 mm crochet hook, sc around neck edge, ending with 104 sc. Fasten off. With size 3.5 mm circular needle and RS facing, pick up and k 1 st in each sc = 104 sts. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Knit 7 rnds. Bind off all sts.






Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **sl** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot St st = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
