

SHAWL · GOMITOLO FELICE

Design 18 – Gomitolo 07



Size 39 x 160 cm

Materials: 300 g of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Felice** (70% cotton, 30% viscose; 435 m/150 g) in Natural/Blackberry/Light Beige/Olive/Amber **(col 716)**. Size 5 mm needles.

Brioche rib: Multiple of 2 + 1 + 2 selvage sts. Row 1 (RS): Selvage st, * k1, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, selvage st. Row 2 (WS): Selvage st, * make a yo, then sl next st pwise, k1; rep from * to last 2 sts, make a yo, then sl next st pwise, selvage st. Row 3 (RS): Selvage st, * ktog slipped st with its yo, make a yo, then sl next st pwise; rep from * to last 2 sts, ktog slipped st with its yo, selvage st. Row 4 (WS): Selvage st, * make a yo, then sl next st pwise, ktog slipped st with its yo; rep from * to last 2 sts, make a yo, then sl next st pwise, selvage st. Work rows 1 - 4 once, then rep rows 3 and 4. Note: 1 stitch and 1 yo are treated as 1 stitch.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

Selvage sts: On RS row: Knit first and last st; on WS row: Purl first and last st.

Lace patt: Multiple of 2 + 1 + 2 selvage sts. Row 1 (RS): Selvage st, k1, * yo, k1; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 2 (WS): Selvage st, * sl next 2 sts pwise to right needle, dropping yos and pulling sts up to elongate, sl 2 sts back to left needle, insert right needle from right to left into first st on left needle, k 2nd st and sl to right needle, k first st and sl to right needle; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, selvage st.


10-row pattern: Work * 8 rows in St st, 2 rows in lace patt; rep from * throughout, end with 8 rows in St st.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Gauges: On size 5 mm needles: 16 sts and 38 rows = 10 x 10 cm in brioche rib; 17 sts and 21 rows = 10 x 10 cm in 10-row patt.

Shawl: With size 5 mm needles cast on 68 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, k23, * k1, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, two-stitch selvage. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, work brioche rib over next 41 sts, work 1 st in rev St st, work 10-row patt over next 23 sts, selvage st. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas approx. 160 cm from cast-on, ending 10-row patt with 8 rows in St st. Next row (WS): Bind off all sts: Bind off 10-row patt sts kwise, bind off brioche rib sts as they appear.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block.






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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
