

SCARVES · GOMITOLO FELICE, GOMITOLO ALOHA & GOMITOLO SOLE

Design 19 – Gomitolo 07



Size <u>Scarf 1</u>: 28 x 160; <u>scarf 2 – 6</u>: 22 x 200 cm [from left to right in photo]

Materials:

<u>Scarf 1</u>: **150 g** of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Felice** (70% cotton, 30% viscose; 435 m/150 g) in Orange/Lind Green/Aubergine/Fuchsia/Petrol/Yellow/Purple **(col 711)**. Size 5.5 mm needles. <u>Scarf 2</u>: **200 g** of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Aloha** (50% cotton, 50% viscose; 250 m/100 g) in Blackberry/Red Violet/Fuchsia/Salmon/Orange Red/Grey Brown/Grey/Plum **(col 309)**. Size 4.5 mm needles.

<u>Scarf 3</u>: **200 g** of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Sole** (58% viscose, 42% cotton; 760 m/200 g) in Red Ombre **(col 914)**. Size 4.5 mm needles.

Scarf 4: **200 g** of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Aloha** (50% cotton, 50% viscose; 250 m/100 g) in Grey Green/Red Violet/Antique Pink/Rust/Yellow/Jade/Petrol/Turquoise **(col 310)**. Size 4.5 mm needles.

<u>Scarf 5</u>: **200 g** of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Sole** (58% viscose, 42% cotton; 760 m/200 g) in Grey Ombre **(col 911)**. Size 4.5 mm needles.

<u>Scarf 6</u>: **200 g** of Lana Grossa **Gomitolo Aloha** (50% cotton, 50% viscose; 250 m/100 g) in Orange/Red/Black-Red/Black/Petrol/Dark Green/Green/Yellow **(col 311)**. Size 4.5 mm needles.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Gauges: In St st: 20 sts and 25 rows = 10×10 cm with size 5.5 mm needles and Felice; 19 sts and 26 rows = 10×10 cm with size 4.5 mm needles and Aloha; 22 sts and 30 rows = 10×10 cm with size 4.5 mm needles and Sole.

<u>Scarf 1</u>: With size 5.5 mm needles and Gomitolo Felice cast on 58 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Working first and last 2 sts as two-stitch selvage, work in St st until yarn is almost used up. Bind off all sts.

<u>Scarf 2</u>: Pulling yarn from outside of ball, with size 4.5 mm needles and Gomitolo Aloha col 309 cast on 44 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Working first and last 2 sts as two-stitch selvage, work in St st until ball is used up. Pulling yarn from center of 2nd ball, cont in patt until yarn is almost used up. Bind off all sts.

<u>Scarf 3</u>: With size 4.5 mm needles and Gomitolo Sole col 914 cast on 52 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Working first and last 2 sts as two-stitch selvage, work in St st until yarn is almost used up. Bind off all sts.

<u>Scarf 4</u>: Pulling yarn from outside of ball, with size 4.5 mm needles and Gomitolo Aloha col 310 cast on 44 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Working first and last 2 sts as two-stitch selvage, work in St st until ball is used up. Pulling yarn from center of 2nd ball, cont in patt until yarn is almost used up. Bind off all sts.

<u>Scarf 5</u>: With size 4.5 mm needles and Gomitolo Sole col 911 cast on 52 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Working first and last 2 sts as two-stitch selvage, work in St st until yarn is almost used up. Bind off all sts.

<u>Scarf 6</u>: Pulling yarn from outside of ball, with size 4.5 mm needles and Gomitolo Aloha col 311 cast on 44 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Working first and last 2 sts as two-stitch selvage, work in St st until ball is used up. Pulling yarn from center of 2nd ball, cont in patt until yarn is almost used up. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block.




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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
