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PULLOVER · ALLORA HAND-DYED
Design 05 – Hand-dyed 02

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Size 36/38 (40, 42/44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 250 (300, 300) g of Lana Grossa **Allora hand-dyed** (76% cotton, 14% superfine Merino wool, 10% baby alpaca; 300 m/50 g) in Peepal (**col 253**). Size 3 and 4 mm needles; size 3 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.

Main patt in rows: Multiple of 5 + 2. Work according to chart. Number at right edge of chart indicates RS row, number at left edge of chart indicates WS row. Rep rows 1 and 2 for main patt.

Main patt in rnds: Rnd 1: Work patt rep around. Rnd 2: * P2, k3; rep from * around.

Slip stitch selvage: On RS row, ktbl first st, sl last st pwise wyib; on WS row, ptbl first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, slip st selvage, 3 sts in main patt, p2tog or skp as needed for patt; at end of RS row, work to last 6 sts, p2tog or k2tog as needed for patt, 3 sts in main patt, slip st selvage.

Gauge: 31 sts and 37 rows = 10 x 10 cm in main patt on size 4 mm needles.

Back: With size 3 mm needles cast on 134 (144, 154) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, work chart row 2 to last st = work to patt rep, work patt rep 26 (28, 30) times; selvage st. NOTE: Selvage sts are not included on chart. Maintaining selvage sts, cont to foll chart until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 4 mm needles. Cont to foll chart until piece meas 40 cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont chart until piece meas 20 (21, 22) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 8 (9, 10) sts 1 time, then 8 sts

2 times, 9 sts 1 time (then 9 sts 1 time, 10 sts 2 times / then 11 sts 3 times). At same time, when working 2nd RS shoulder bind-off row, shape neck as foll: Bind off center 64 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 1 time. No sts rem.

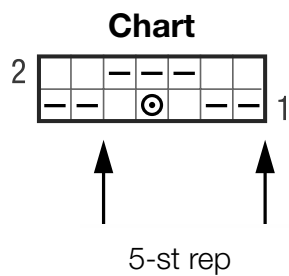
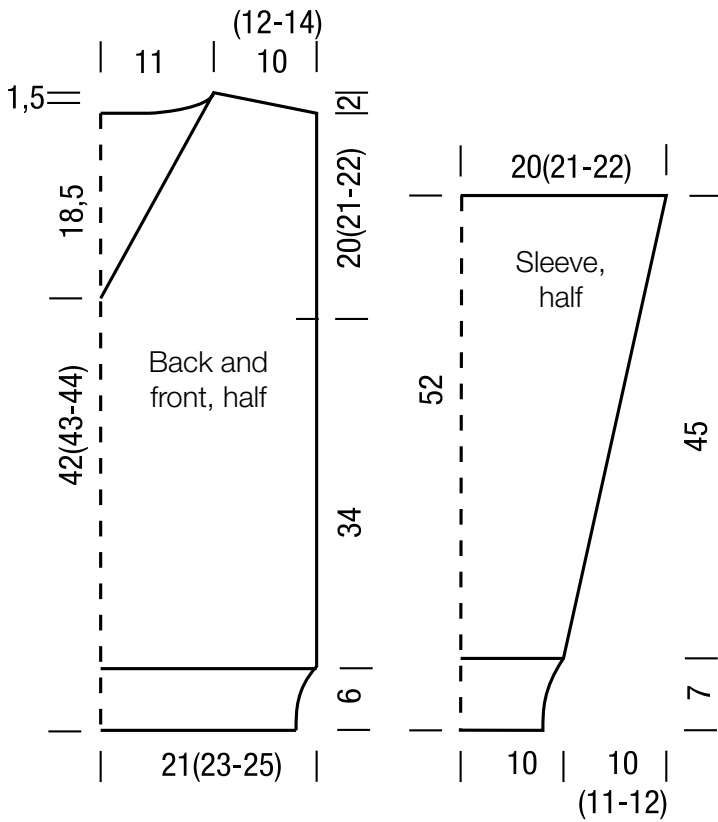
Front: Work same as back until piece meas 42 (43, 44) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape V-neck: Next row (RS): Divide work at center. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec (note slip st selvage), dec 1 st at each neck edge [on foll RS row, then foll alt RS row] 2 times, then every foll RS row 30 times and when same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

Sleeves: With size 3 mm needles cast on 64 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, work chart row 2 to last st = work to patt rep, work patt rep 12 times; selvage st. NOTE: Selvage sts are not included on chart. Maintaining selvage sts, cont to foll chart until piece meas 7 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 4 mm needles. Cont to foll chart and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 7th row from needle change, then every 6th row 11 times, then every alt 4th and 6th row 18 times (then every alt 4th and 6th row 25 times, then every 4th row 8 times / then every alt 4th and 6th row 14 times, then every 4th row 22 times) = 124 (132, 128) sts. Work increased sts into patt. Work even until piece meas 52 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. **Neckband:** With size 3 mm circular needle, beg at right shoulder, pick up and k 68 sts along back neck edge (= 1 st in each bound-off st), 56 sts each along left and right V-neck edge = 180 sts. Matching patt of picked-up sts to bound-off sts at back neck edge and with 3 sts at bottom V as 3 knit sts, work main patt in rnds and work double dec at center V on every alt rnd 7 times as foll: Work to 1 st before center V sts, k2tog, skp. Work 1 rnd even. Bind off all sts as they appear, work center double dec once more while binding off. Band meas approx. 3.5 cm. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
