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SLIPOVER · CASHMERE PURO

Design 30 – Classici 21

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 225 (250, 275) g of Lana Grossa **Cashmere Puro** (100% cashmere; 80 m/25 g) in Silver Grey (**col 2**). Size 5 mm needles; size 5 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.

Rib patt: Multiple of 2 + 1 + 2 selvage sts. **Row 1 (RS):** K1 for selvage st, * p1, k1tbl; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1 for selvage st. **Row 2 (WS):** P1 for selvage st, * k1, p1tbl; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, p1 for selvage st. Rep rows 1 and 2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, two-stitch selvage, k1, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, k2tog, k1, two-stitch selvage.

Gauge: 19 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 5 mm needles.

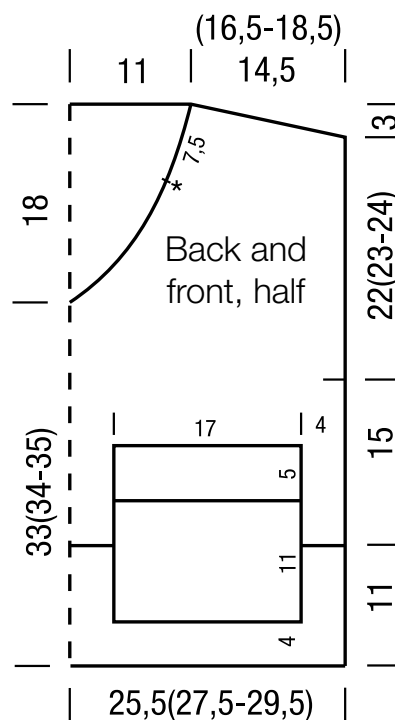
Back: With size 5 mm needles cast on 109 (117, 125) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in rib patt until piece meas 11 cm from cast-on, decreasing 9 sts evenly across last WS row = 100 (108, 116) sts. Work in St st until piece meas 26 cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Working a two-stitch selvage at each edge, cont in St st until piece meas 22 (23, 24) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders: At each shoulder edge bind off 7 (8, 9) sts 1 time, then 7 sts 2 times, 8 sts 1 time (then 8 sts 2 times, 9 sts 1 time / then 9 sts 2 times, 10 sts 1 time). Bind off rem 42 sts.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 33 (34, 35) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape V-neck: Next row (RS): Divide work at center = 50 (54, 58) sts each side. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge on first RS row, then every alt RS

row 2 times, then every foll RS row 18 times and when same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

Pockets: Make 2. With size 5 mm needles cast on 41 sts. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, * k1, p1tbl; rep from * to last 3 sts, k1, two-stitch selvage. Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Maintaining two-stitch selvage, work in St st until piece meas 16 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

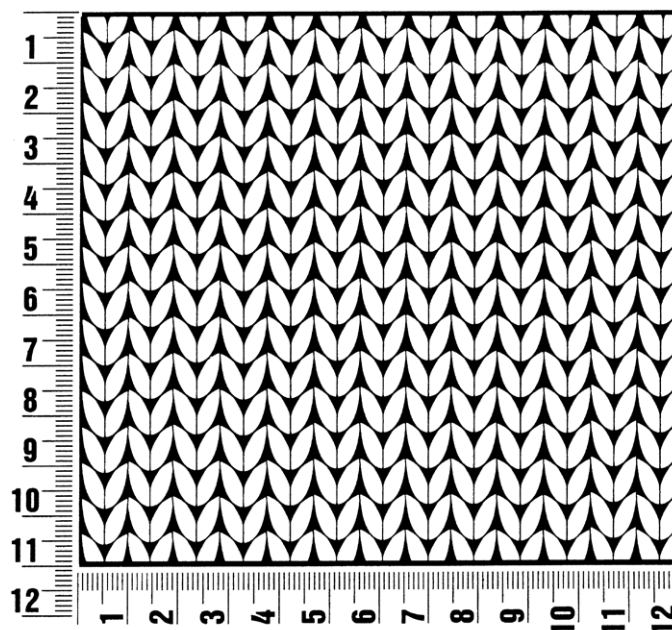
Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Referring to schematic for placement, sew pockets to front. Sew shoulder and side seams. **Collar:** With size 5 mm circular needle, RS facing, beg and end at * on schematic, pick up and k 75 sts evenly along neck edge. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, * k1tbl, p1; rep from * to last 3 sts, k1tbl, two-stitch selvage. Cont in rib patt as set by last row until collar meas 12 cm, ending with a RS row. Loosely bind off all sts kwise.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
