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SLIPOVER · CASHMERE PURO

Design 35 – Classici 21

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 350 (375, 400) g of Lana Grossa **Cashmere Puro** (100% cashmere; 80 m/25 g) in Camel (**col 29**). Size 3, 3.5 and 4 mm needles; size 3 mm circular needle, 40 cm long; cable needle [cn].

Rib patt: K1, p1.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

Chart patt 1: Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows; on WS rows, work sts as they appear. Rep rows 1 – 12.

Chart patt 2: Multiple of 8. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows; on WS rows, work sts as they appear. Work rows 1 – 14 once, then rep rows 3 – 14.

Chart patt 3: Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows; on WS rows, work sts as they appear. Work rows 1 – 42 once, then rep rows 3 – 42.

Chart patt 4: Number at right edge of chart indicates RS row, number at left edge of chart indicates WS row. Rep rows 1 and 2.

Cable A and B: Numbers at right edge of charts indicate RS rows; on WS rows, work sts as they appear. Work rows 1 – 10 once, then rep rows 5 – 10.

Gauges: On size 4 mm needles: 25.5 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in chart patt 2; 20 sts of chart patt 3 = 8 cm wide; 10 sts of chart patt 1 = 3.5 cm wide; 6 sts of cable A and/or B = 2.5 cm wide.

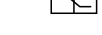
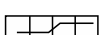
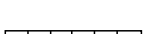
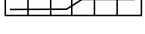
Back: With size 3 mm needles cast on 127 (135, 143) sts. Work in rib patt until piece meas 7 cm from cast-on, increasing 23 sts evenly across last WS row = 150 (158, 166) sts. Change to size 4 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 3 (4, 5) sts in rev St st, 10 sts cable patt 1, 1 (2, 3) st(s) in rev St st, 20 sts cable patt 3, 1 (2, 3) st(s) in rev St st, 4 sts cable A, 3 (4, 5) sts in rev St st, 64 sts cable patt 2 = work to patt rep, work patt rep 6 times, work to end of chart; 3 (4, 5) sts in rev St st, 4 sts cable B, 1 (2, 3) st(s) in rev St st, 20 sts cable patt 3, 1 (2, 3) st(s) in rev St st, 10 sts cable patt 1, 3 (4, 5) sts in rev St st, selvage st. Next 2 rows: Work in patt as set by last row = 154 (162, 170) sts. Cont in patt as established until piece meas 62 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 14 sts 1 time, then 14 sts 1 time, 13 sts 2 times (then 14 sts 1 time, 15 sts 2 times / then 16 sts 3 times). **At same time**, on first row of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Bind off center 26 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 3 sts 1 time, 2 sts 1 time, 1 st 1 time. No sts rem.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 38 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape V-neck: Next row (RS): Divide work at center = 77 (81, 85) sts each side. Working each side separately, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 18 times, then every alt RS row 5 times = 54 (58, 62) sts each side and when same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

Armhole bands: Make 2. With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 9 sts. Work chart patt 4 for 44 (46, 48) cm. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. **Neckband:** With size 3 mm circular needle, pick up and k 195 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. With st at bottom V as a knit st, work rib patt in rnds and work double dec at center V on every alt rnd as foll: Work to 1 st before center V st, sl 2 kwise, k1, pass slipped sts over knitted st. When neckband meas 4 cm loosely bind off all sts in rib. Place markers 22 (23, 24) cm down from shoulders on front and back. Sew on armhole bands between markers. Sew side seams.

Chart key:

-  = selvage st: k1 on RS, sl 1 pwise wyif on WS
-  = sl 1 pwise wyib
-  = k1
-  = p1
-  = M1R
-  = sl 1 st to cn and hold in back of work, k1, then k1 from cn
-  = sl 1 st to cn and hold in front of work, k1, then k1 from cn
-  = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in back of work, k2, then k2 from cn
-  = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k2, then k2 from cn
-  = sl 3 sts to cn and hold in back of work, k3, then k3 from cn
-  = sl 3 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k3, then k3 from cn
-  = sl 4 sts to cn and hold in back of work, k2, then p2, k2 from cn
-  = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k2, p2, then k2 from cn
-  = sl 1 st to cn and hold in front of work, p1, then k1 from cn
-  = sl 1 st to cn and hold in back of work, k1, then p1 from cn
-  = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, p1, then k2 from cn
-  = sl 1 st to cn and hold in back of work, k2, then p1 from cn

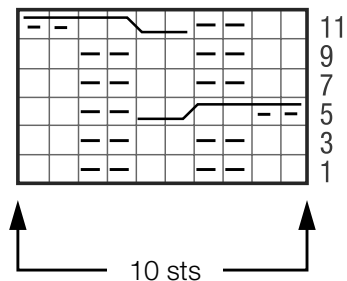

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
