

SCARF · PIÙ BELLA Design 04 – Lookbook 12



Size 34 x 180 cm

Materials: Lana Grossa Più Bella (59% baby alpaca, 20% polyamide, 15% cashmere, 6% Merino wool; 100 m/25 g). Scarf A: 25 g each in Beige (col 2), Orange (col 3), Pink (col 4), Antique Pink (col 5) and Pale Purple (col 6). Scarf B: 25 g each in Off White (col 1), Mint (col 7), Grey Green (col 8), Grey Blue (col 9) and Yellow (col 10). Size 5 mm needles.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Selvage sts: <u>On RS row</u>, ktbl first st, sl last st pwise wyib. <u>On</u> <u>WS row</u>, ptbl first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Gauge: 16 sts and 25 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 5 mm needles.


Scarf: With size 5 mm needles and Beige for scarf A or Off White for scarf B, cast on 59 sts. Next row (RS): Selvage st, * k1, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as set by last row for a total of 6 rows. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 4 sts in rib patt as established, 49 sts in St st, 4 sts in rib patt as established, selvage st. Work in patt as set by last row, work each color for chosen scarf in sequence as listed under Materials for approx. 36 cm or until color is used up. Work last 6 rows (in Pale Purple for scarf A, in Yellow for scarf B) in rib patt. Bind off all sts in rib.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **sl** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot St st = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
