# LANA GROSSA



Design 14 – Gomitolo 09

PULLOVER
GOMITOLO SELEZIONE 2 & GOMITOLO ALOHA

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**Size** 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 (400, 450, 450) g of Lana Grossa Gomitolo Selezione 2 (75% cotton, 25% viscose; 260 m/100 g) in Reed/Plum/Grey Purple/Straw Green/Light Grey (col 2005); 400 (400, 450, 450) g of Lana Grossa Gomitolo Aloha (50% cotton, 50% viscose; 250 m/100 g) in Vanilla/White Green/Light Green/Light Grey/Ice Blue (col 315). Size 5 and 5.5 mm needles; short size 5 mm circular needle.

**Note**: Work with 1 strand of each yarn held tog throughout = 2 strands held tog.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

**Brioche rib**: Row 1 (RS): \* K1; make a yo, then sl next st pwise; rep from \*, end k1. Row 2 (WS): \* Make a yo, then sl next st pwise; ktog slipped st with its yo; rep from \*, end make a yo, then sl next st pwise. Row 3 (RS): \* Ktog slipped st with its yo; make a yo, then sl next st pwise; rep from \*, end ktog slipped st with its yo. Work rows 1 – 3 once, then rep rows 2 and 3. Note: 1 stitch and 1 yo are treated as 1 stitch.

**Gauge**: 12 sts and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm in brioche rib with size 5.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.


**Full-fashion dbl decrease**: At beg of RS row, selvage st, 2 sts in brioche rib, sk2p; at end of RS row, work to last 6 sts, k3tog, 2 sts in brioche rib, selvage st.

**Back**: With size 5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 68 (72, 76, 80) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in rib patt for 3 cm. Change to size 5.5 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in brioche rib for 19 (17, 17, 15) cm (measured hanging from needle), ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Bind off 2 (2, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work even for 6 rows. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each end of next RS row, then every 8th row 8 (9, 9, 10) times and when raglan meas 23 (25, 25, 27) cm, bind off rem 28 sts.

**Front**: Work same as back until raglan meas 19 (21, 21, 23) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 12 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 4 times. No sts rem.

**Sleeves**: With size 5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 44 (48, 52, 56) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in rib patt for 3 cm. Change to size 5.5 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in brioche rib and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of every 8th row 4 times = 52 (56, 60, 64) sts. Work even until piece meas 19 (17, 17, 15) cm from end of rib patt (measured hanging from needle), ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 2 (2, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work even for 6 rows. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each end of next RS row, then every 8th row 8 (9, 9, 10) times and when cap meas 23 (25, 25, 27) cm, bind off rem 12 sts.

**Finishing**: Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams. <u>Neckband</u>: With size 5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 84 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work rib patt in rnds for 3 cm. Loosely bind off all sts in rib.






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#### Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
