Design 20 – Gomitolo 09

CROCHET PONCHO
GOMITOLO SELEZIONE 3 & ALTA MODA COTOLANA

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Size One size

Materials: 300 g of Lana Grossa Gomitolo Selezione 3 (65% cotton, 35% acrylic; 270 m/100 g) Jade/Orange/Dark Green/Raspberry/Yellow/Grey Green/Light Grey (col 3005) and 250 g of Lana Grossa Alta Moda Cotolana (45% Merino wool, 45% Pima cotton, 10% polyamide; 150 m/50 g) in White (col 18). Size 4 mm crochet hook; 1 stitch holder.

Crochet patt: Work in rnds according to chart. Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), ch 2, [sk next 2 ch, 3 dc in next ch, ch 1] 16 times, ch 1 and place marker, [sk next 2 ch, 3 dc in next ch, ch 1] 15 times, sk next 2 ch, 2 dc in next ch, sl st in top of beg ch-3. Change yarn, sl st in next ch on rnd below. Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), ch 2, 3 dc into ch-2 sp before first dc group on rnd below, ch 1, [3 dc into ch-1 sp on rnd below, ch 1] around (exception: work [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] into ch-2 sp at marker), end with 2 dc into first ch-1 sp on rnd below, sl st in top of beg ch-3. Work rnd 1 once, then rep rnd 2, changing yarns every rnd.

Gauge: 16 sts and 8 rnds = 10×10 cm in crochet patt with size 4 mm hook.

Poncho: With size 4 mm hook and Gomitolo Selezione 3, ch 96, sl st in first ch to form ring. Work crochet patt according to chart for 48 rnds, then work 1 more rnd in White. Fasten off.

<u>Fringe</u>: Cut a total of 102 fringe. For each fringe, cut 4 strands of yarn, each strand approx. 36 cm long. Attach fringe after every other dc group around bottom edge of poncho




Chart key:

= double crochet (dc)




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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
