



Design 15 – Lookbook 16

PULLOVER RICCIO

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50, 52/54)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 (400, 450, 500, 550) g of Lana Grossa **Riccio** (84% cotton, 16% polyamide; 110 m/50 g) in May Green (col 16). Size 5 and 5.5 mm needles; short size 5 mm circular needle.

Rib patt: Selvage st, * P1, k1; rep from *, end selvage st.

Chart patt: Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows; on WS rows purl all sts, purl into first yo and ktbl into second yo. Rep rows 1 – 4.

Gauge: 18 sts and 22 rows = 10 x 10 cm in chart patt on size 5.5 mm needles.

Back: With size 5 mm needles cast on 98 (104, 110, 116, 122) sts. Work in rib patt for 4 cm, increasing 8 (10, 12, 14, 16) sts evenly across last WS row = 106 (114, 122, 130, 138) sts. Change to size 5.5 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work chart until piece meas 36 cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont in patt until piece meas 18 (20, 22, 24, 26) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Bind off all sts.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 10 (12, 14, 16, 18) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 18 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 3 times and when same length as back to shoulders, bind off rem 34 (38, 42, 46, 50) sts for each shoulder.

Sleeves: Sleeves are picked up along armhole edge and worked down to cuff edge. Sew shoulder seams. With size 5.5 mm needles and RS facing, pick up and k 66 (74, 82, 90, 98) sts evenly between armhole markers. Purl 1 WS row. Working first and last st as selvage sts, work chart until piece meas 38 (36, 34, 32, 30) cm from pick-up row, ending with a WS row. Change to size 5 mm needles. Work in rib patt for 4 cm, decreasing 24 (30, 36, 42, 48) sts evenly on first row = 42 (44, 46, 48, 50) sts. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Sew side and sleeve seams. **Neck trim:** With size 5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 98 sts evenly around neck edge. Knit 1 rnd. Bind off all sts kwise.

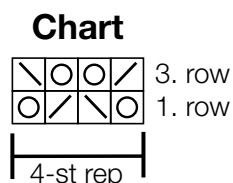
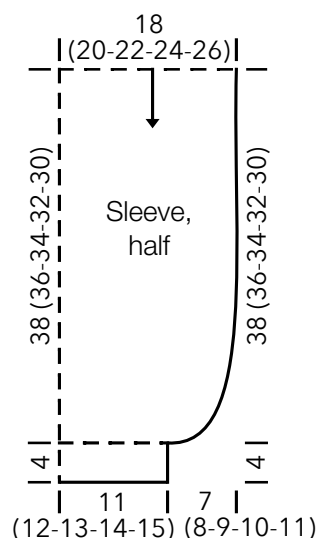
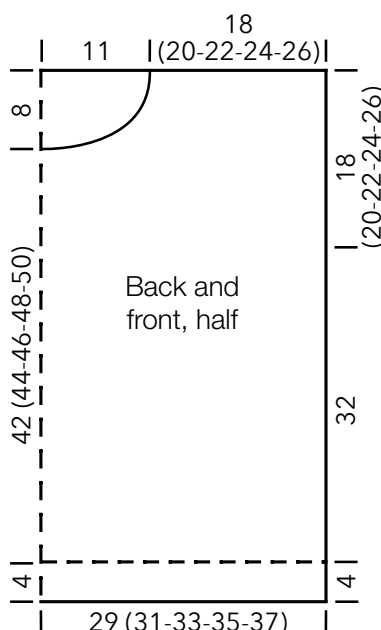


Chart key:

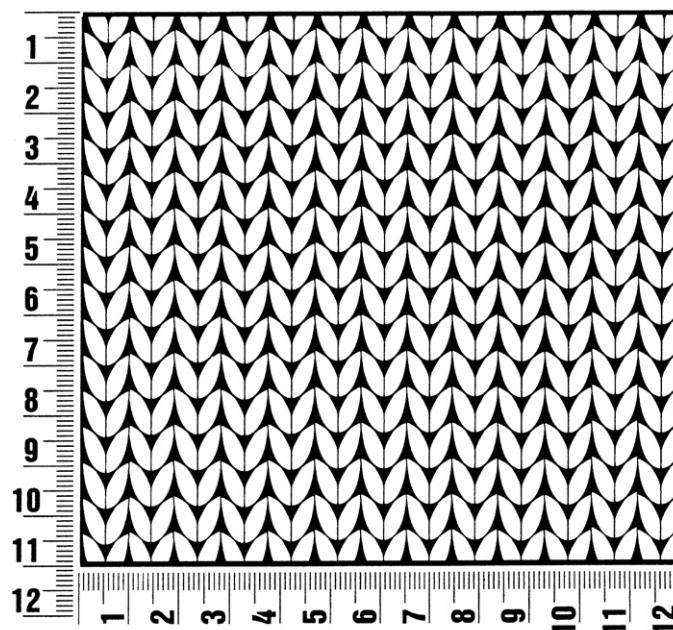
- = yo

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvedge stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
