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Design 6 – Lookbook 20

PULLOVER CORALLO

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 500 (500, 600, 600) g of Lana Grossa **Corallo** (70% organic cotton, 30% Merino wool; 210 m/100 g) in Raspberry/Red (**col 2**). Short and long size 4, 4.5 and 5 mm circular needles; one set each size 4, 4.5 and 5 mm double-pointed needles [dpns]; stitch markers; stitch holders.

St st in rnds: K every rnd.

Rib patt: *P1, k1*, rep *-*. On foll rnds work sts as they appear.

Raglan incs: *Knit to M, M1R(k), SM, k2, SM, M1L(k)*, rep *-* 3 more times = 8 sts increased.

M1R(k)

Lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop.

M1L(k)

Lift strand between sts from the front and knit this strand through the back loop.

Markers: M = marker; PM = place marker; SM = slide marker.

Gauge: 18 sts and 26 rows/rnds = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 5 mm needles.

Note: Pullover is worked seamlessly from the top down.

Neckband: Using size 4 mm circular needle cast on 110 sts. PM0 for beg of rnd and join for working in rnds. Knit 4 rnds.

Change to size 4.5 mm circular needle. Work in rib patt for 4 rnds, placing markers on last rnd as foll: 17 sts in rib patt (= right shoulder), PM, 2 sts in rib patt, PM, 34 sts in rib patt (= front), PM, 2 sts in rib patt, PM, 17 sts in rib patt (= left shoulder), PM, 2 sts in rib patt, PM, 34 sts in rib patt (= back), PM, 2 sts in rib patt, PM, SM0.

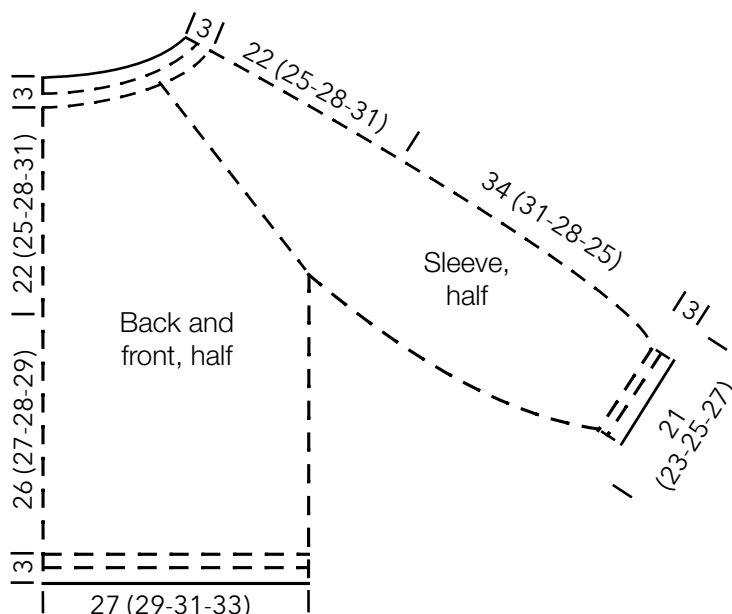
Yoke: Change to size 5 mm circular needle. **Rnd 1:** Work raglan incs. **Rnd 2:** Knit all sts. Work rnds 1 and 2 a total of 29 (33, 37, 41) times = 58 (66, 74, 82) rnds total and 342 (374, 406, 438) sts: 75 (83, 91, 99) sts for each sleeve, 92 (100, 108, 116) sts each for back and front and 8 raglan sts. **Note:** End last rnd at last raglan marker before M0.

Divide for body and sleeves: Place next 75 (83, 91, 99) sts on holder for sleeve, cast on 2 sts for underarm, k96 (104, 112, 120) = 2 raglan sts + 92 (100, 108, 116) front sts + 2 raglan sts, place next 75 (83, 91, 99) holder for sleeve, cast on 2 sts for underarm, k96 (104, 112, 120) = 2 raglan sts + 92 (100, 108, 116) back sts + 2 raglan sts = 196 (212, 228, 244) sts for body.

Body: Cont in rnds until body meas 26 (27, 28, 29) cm from underarm. Change to size 4.5 mm circular needle. Work in rib patt for 4 rnds. Knit 4 rnds. Bind off all sts.

Sleeves: Using shorter size 5 mm circular needle or dpns and with RS facing, knit 75 (83, 91, 99) held sleeve sts, pick up and k 3 sts in underarm cast-on = 78 (86, 94, 102) sts. PM for beg of rnd and join for working in rnds. Cont in rnds until sleeve meas 34 (31, 28, 25) cm, decreasing 32 (36, 40, 44) sts evenly on last rnd = 46 (50, 54, 58) sts. Change to size 4.5 mm dpns. Work in rib patt for 4 rnds. Change to size 4 mm dpns. Knit 4 rnds. Bind off all sts.

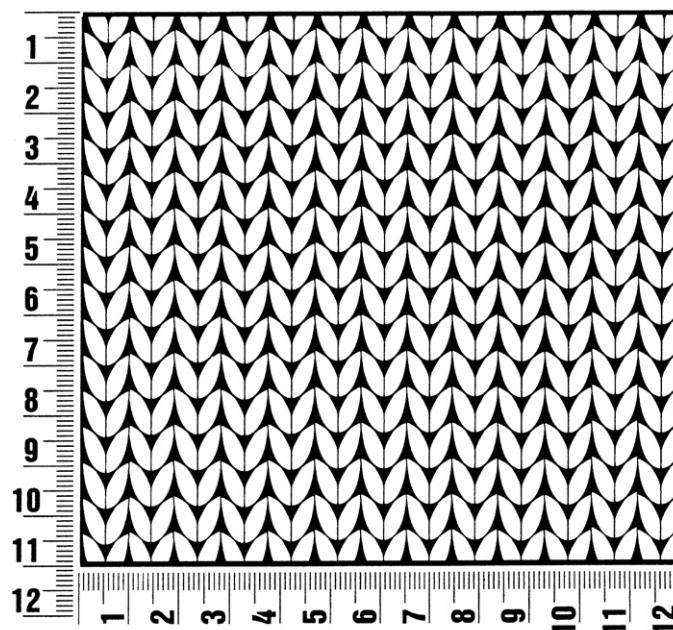
Finishing: Carefully weave in all ends. If needed, close small gaps at underarms.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvedge stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
