## TOP

**Size** 36/38 (40/42 - 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

**Materials:** Lana Grossa **Promessa** (70 % Cotton, 30 % Polyamide, approx. 125 m/50 g), **300 (350 - 400) g camel (col 42)**; knitting needles no. 5 and 6,5, circular knitting needles no. 4, 40 cm.

**Garter st :** RS and WS-row: k all sts

**St st:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Irish moss st:** multiples of 2 + selvedge sts.

**Row 1 (RS-row):** selvedge st, \*k1, p1\* rep cont, selvedge st.

**Row 2 + 4:** work sts as they appear. **Row 3 (WS-row):** selvedge st, \*p1, k1\* rep cont, selvedge st. Rep rows 1-4 throughout.

**Eyelet patt:** multiples of 3 + selvedge sts.

**Row 1 (RS-row):** k all sts **Row 2 (WS-row):** selvedge st, \*yo, p1\* rep cont, selvedge st. **Row 3 (RS-row):** selvedge st, \*sl 3 sts and drop their yo's, lift those 3 sts back onto the left needle, k3tog tbl, yo and k3tog tbl the same 3 sts\* rep cont, selvedge st. **Row 4 (WS-row):** P all sts and yo.

**Trinity st:** multiples of 4 + selvedge sts. **Row 1:** p all sts. **Row 2:** selvedge st, \*all in the same foll st: k1, p1, k1; p3tog\* rep cont, selvedge st. **Row 3:** p all sts. **Row 4:** selvedge st, \*p3tog, all in the same foll st: k1, p1, k1;\* rep cont, selvedge st. Rep rows 1-4 throughout.

**Patt sequence:** 4 rows garter st, 4 rows eyelet patt, 4 rows garter st, 14 rows irish moss st, 2 rows St st, 4 rows garter st, 4 rows eyelet patt, 2 rows St st, 4 rows garter st, 2 rows St st, whilst evenly increasing 2 sts on the WS-row, 12 rows trinity patt, 2 rows St st, whilst evenly decreasing 2 sts on the RS-row (0 sts dec. - 2 sts incr.), 4 rows garter st, 2 rows St st, 4 rows eyelet patt, 4 rows garter st, 2 rows St st, 4 rows eyelet patt, whilst evenly increasing 2 sts on the WS-row (0 sts inc. - 2 sts dec.), finish panel in trinity patt.

**Garter st selvedge:** K the 1st and last st on each row

**Double st selvedge:** work the first and last 2 sts on every row as follows

RS-row: sl1 p-wise wyif, k1

Row-end: sl1 p-wise wyif, k1

**Gauge:** 18 sts and 28 rows on average = 10 x 10 cm in patt sequence on size 6,5 mm needles.

**Back panel:** With needles no. 5 cast on 104 (110 - 116) sts and k 1 WS-row. Cont in patt sequence with garter stitch selvedge sts, and after 4 rows in garter stitch switch to needles no. 6,5.

At a total height of 23 cm, mark the beginning of the armholes at both sides and increase 1 st on each side = 106 (112 - 118) sts. Now cont working with double st selvedges at both sides.

At an armhole height of 24 (25 - 26) cm, begin shoulder shaping: bind off 4 (5 - 5) sts at both sides once, then on every 2nd row: bind off 2x 4 sts and 4x 5 sts (6x5 sts - 3x5 sts and 3x6 sts) at both sides.

At a total height of 52 (53 - 54) cm, bind off the remaining 42 sts.

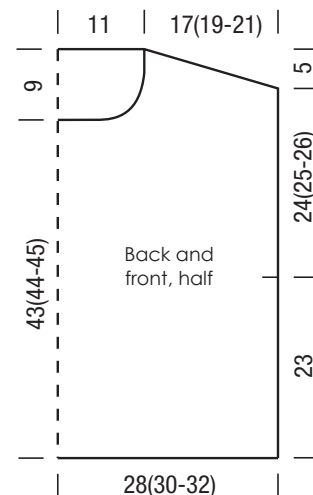
**Front panel:** Work according to back panel instr.

At a total height of 43 (44 - 45) cm, bind off the middle 22 sts for the neckline, then decrease on every 2nd row: 1x3 sts, 2x2 sts, and 3x1 st.

At a total height of 47 (48 - 49) cm, work the shoulder shaping as for the back piece.

**Finishing:** Moisten, block and let the panels air dry. Close shoulder and side seams.

For the neckband, pick up 105 sts along the neckline. With circular needles no. 4 p 1 rnd and k 1 rnd, then bind off all sts k-wise. Close the side seams up to the markers.

## GAUGE SWATCH

Before you start knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and stitch pattern for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would do with the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If you count more stitches or rows, switch to larger needles. If you count fewer stitches or rows, switch to smaller needles.
