# LOOKBOOK No. 4 

## PULLOVER



PULLOVER

Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)
Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 250 (300, 350) g of Lana Grossa Alcanto (70\% polyester, $30 \%$ polyamide; $130 \mathrm{~m} / 50 \mathrm{~g}$ ) in Light Beige (col 1). Size 8 mm needles; size 7 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.

Reverse stockinette: P on $\mathrm{RS}, \mathrm{k}$ on WS.
Stockinette in rnds: K every rnd.
Slip garter selvage: Knit the first st of every row and slip the last st of every row as if to purl with yarn in front of work.
Gauge: 10.5 sts and 15 rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in reverse stockinette on size 8 mm needles.

Back: Worked side to side. Arrow on schematic shows direction of work.
With size 8 mm needles, cast on $59(61,63)$ sts. Next WS row: Slip garter selvage, [k1, p1] twice, work in reverse stockinette over $53(55,57)$ sts, slip garter selvage.
Work in pat as established for 50 $(54,58) \mathrm{cm}$, then bind off all sts.
Front: Worked side to side. Arrow on schematic shows direction of work.
With size 8 mm needles, cast on $59(61,63)$ sts. Next WS row:


Slip garter selvage, [k1, p1] twice, work in reverse stockinette over $53(55,57)$ sts, slip garter selvage st. Work in pat as established for 15.5 (17.5, 19.5) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape V-neck: Bind off 5 sts at beg of next RS row, 4 sts at beg of next 6 RS rows $=30(32,34)$ sts. Cast on 4 sts at beg of next 6 RS rows, 5 sts at beg of next RS row $=59(61,63)$ sts. Cont until front measures $50(54,58) \mathrm{cm}$ from beg, then bind off all sts.
Sleeves: With size 8 mm needles, cast on 34 sts. Next RS row: Slip garter selvage, * k1, p1; rep from * to last st, slip garter selvage. Next WS row: Work sts as they appear. Maintaining the slip garter selvage, work in reverse stockinette and shape sleeve as foll: For size 40/42, inc 1 st at beg and end of 25 th row, then every foll 26 th row once. For size 44/46, inc 1 st at beg and end of 17th row, then every foll 16th row once, then every foll 14th row twice $=$ $34(38,42)$ sts. Cont until sleeve measures $54(52,50) \mathrm{cm}$ from cast-on, then bind off all sts.
Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. With size 7 mm circular needle, pick up and knit 81 sts around neck edge. Join for working in rnds and work stockinette in rnds for 3 cm . Bind off all sts. Place markers 15.5 (17.5, 19.5) cm down from shoulders on front and back. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

## GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...
...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. $12 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ 12 cm . Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm . If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
