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Design 21

PULLOVER





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Size 36 – 42 One size fits all.

Materials: 150 g each of Lana Grossa Fourseason (45% extrafine Merino wool, 40% organic cotton, 15% recycled cashmere; 105 m/50 g) in Coral (col 16), Grey/Beige (col 10) and Violet (col 14) and 50 g each in Yellow (col 8), Light Petrol (col 6) and Natural (col 12). Size 6.5 mm needles; size 6.5 mm circular needles, 50, 80 and 100 cm long; size 6 mm circular needle, 50 cm long.

6x6 rib: K6, p6.

2x2 rib: K2, p2.

Stripe patt A [back and front]: Work 22 rows/rnds each with Coral, Grey/Beige, Violet, Natural, Light Petrol and Yellow.

Stripe patt B [sleeves]: Work 20 rows with Coral, 50 rows with Grey/Beige [22 rows in 6x6 rib, 28 rows in 2x2 rib], 20 rows with Violet, then 22 rows/rnds each with Natural, Light Petrol and Yellow.

Full-fashion dec A [side and sleeve shaping]: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k2tog or p2tog as needed to stay in patt; at end of RS row, work to last 3 sts, skp or p2tog as needed to stay in patt, selvage st.

Full-fashion dec B [raglan shaping]: At beg of each piece, k1, p2, k5tog; at end of each piece, work to last 8 sts, sl 1 kwise, k4tog, pass slipped st over knitted st, p2, k1 – 4 sts decreased at each end of each piece.

Gauge: 16 sts and 24.5 rows/rnds = 10 x 10 cm in 6x6 and 2x2 rib on size 6.5 mm needles.


Back: With size 6.5 mm needles and Coral, cast on 98 sts. Next row (RS): Selvage st, p3, * k6, p6; rep from *, end last rep with p3, selvage st. Cont in 6x6 rib as established, work stripe patt A and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion dec A, dec 1 st at each end of 5th row worked with Grey/Beige, then every 4th row 4 times = 88 sts. Work 1 WS row to end of 22-row Grey/Beige stripe. Break Grey/Beige, cont with Violet as foll: Next row (RS): Selvage st, p2tog, k2, * p2, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2tog, selvage st = 86 sts. Cont in 2x2 rib as established, rep dec row on next RS row, then every 4th row 4 times = 78 sts. Work 3 more rows to end of 22-row Violet stripe. Break Violet. With Natural, cont in 2x2 rib for 6 rows, ending with a WS row. Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Place rem 74 sts on holder.

Front: Work same as for back.

Sleeves: With size 6.5 mm needles and Coral, cast on 74 sts. Next row (RS): Selvage st, p3, * k6, p6; rep from *, end last rep with p3, selvage st. Cont in 6x6 rib as established, work stripe patt B and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion dec A, dec 1 st at each end of 9th row worked with Grey/Beige, then every 8th row once = 70 sts. Work 5 more rows in 6x6 rib, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Cont in 2x2 rib and stripe patt B, rep dec row on foll RS row, then every 8th row once, then every 6th row 6 times = 54 sts. Work 1 WS row to end of 20-row Violet stripe. Break Violet. With Natural, cont in 2x2 rib for 6 rows, ending with a WS row. Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Place rem 50 sts on holder.

Yoke: SI sts for sleeve, front, sleeve and back to longest size 6.5 mm circular needle, placing a marker between each piece = 248 sts. Join for working in rnds. Rnd 1: With Natural, work in 2x2 rib and <u>at same time</u>, k2tog first 2 sts and last 2 sts of each piece = 240 sts. Cont in 2x2 rib and stripe patt and working full-fashion dec B, dec 32 sts every 10th rnd 3 times, then every 8th rnd twice = 80 sts. Change to shorter size 6.5 mm circular needles as st count decreases. Work even until yoke meas approx. 23.5 cm and a total of 58 rnds has been worked from beg of yoke, ending with 22-rnd Yellow stripe. Change to size 6 mm circular needle. K 6 rnds. Loosely bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block. Sew side, underarm and sleeve seams.






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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
