**PULLOVER** 



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**PULLOVER** 

**Size** 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 (450, 500) g of Lana Grossa Landlust Merino 180 (100% superwash Merino wool; 180 m/50 g) in Lilac (col 237). Size 5.5 and 6 mm needles; size 5.5 mm circular needle, 40 cm long; cable needle [cn].

2x3 rib: P2, k3.

2x2 rib: P2, k2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

**Full-fashion dec 1**: At beg of RS row, selvage st, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in back of work, k2tog, then k2tog from cn; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, skp, then k2tog from cn, selvage st – 2 sts decreased at each edge.

**Full-fashion dec 2**: At beg of RS row, selvage st, 4 sts in rev St st, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in back of work, k2tog, then k2tog from cn; at end of RS row, work to last 9 sts, sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, skp, then k2tog from cn, 4 sts in rev St st, selvage st – 2 sts decreased at each edge.

Full-fashion inc: On RS row, M1R, 2 sts in from each edge.

**Gauge**: 18 sts and 26 rows =  $10 \times 10$  cm in St st on size 6 mm needles.

**Back**: With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 137 (147, 157) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, k1, \* p3, k2; rep from \* to last 5 sts, p3, k1, selvage st. Cont in 2x3 rib as established until piece meas 10 cm, decreasing 45 (47, 49) sts evenly across last WS row = 92 (100, 108) sts. Change to size 6 mm needles. Work in St st and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 9th row, then every alt 6th and 8th row 3 times = 100 (108, 116) sts. Work even until piece meas 24 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape rag-

lan: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows = 92 (100, 108) sts. Work 6 rows even. Next RS (dec) row: Working full-fashion dec 1, dec 2 sts at each end of row = 88 (96, 104) sts. Cont in St st, rep dec row every 6th row 11 times, then every 4th row 1 (3, 5) times = 40 sts. Work 1 WS row. Place rem 40 sts on holder.

**Front**: Work same as back to raglan, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows = 92 (100, 108) sts. Work 6 rows even. Next RS (dec) row: Working full-fashion dec 1, dec 2 sts at each end of row = 88 (96, 104) sts. Cont in St st, rep dec row every 6th row 10 times, then every 4th row 1 (3, 5) times. At same time, when piece meas 50 (51, 52) cm from cast-on, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 14 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge 3 times. No sts rem.

**Left sleeve**: With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 50 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p1, \* k2, p2; rep from \* to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Cont in 2x2 rib as established until piece meas 3 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 6 mm needles. Work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 3rd row, then every alt 4th and 6th row 12 (11, 10) times, then every alt row 11 (14, 17) times = 98 (102, 106) sts. Work even until piece meas 37 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows = 90 (94, 98) sts. Work 4 rows even. Next RS (dec) row: Working full-fashion dec 2, dec 2 sts at each end of row = 86 (90, 94) sts. Cont in St st, rep dec row every 4th row 16 (17, 18) times = 22 sts. Work 2 rows even. \* Next row (WS): Bind off 4 sts, work to end. Next row (RS): Dec 2 sts, work to end. Rep from \* 2 times. Next row (WS): Bind off rem 4 sts.

**Right sleeve**: Work same as left sleeve, reversing cap shaping.


**Finishing**: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan seams. Neckband: With size 5.5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 115 sts evenly around neck edge including sts on back neck holder. Join for working in rnds. Work p2/k3 rib in rnds until band meas 7 cm from pick-up rnd. Loosely bind off all sts in rib. Fold neckband in half to WS and sew down. Sew side and sleeve seams


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




### Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
