Design 9

PULLOVER



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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 300 (350, 400) g of Lana Grossa **About Berlin Funky** (83% cotton, 17% polyamide; 115 m/50 g) in Grey **(col 4).** Size 5.5 mm needles; size 5 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.


St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Elongated stitch patt: Row 1 (RS): Selvage st, * yo twice, k1; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 2 (WS): Purl all sts, dropping all yos and pulling sts up to elongate. Row 3: Knit. Row 4: Purl. Row 5: Knit. Row 6: Selvage st, * yo twice, p1; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 7: Knit all sts, dropping all yos and pulling sts up to elongate. Row 8: Purl. Row 9: Knit. Row 10: Purl. Row 11: As row 1. Row 12: As row 2.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, two-stitch selvage, p2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, p2tog, two-stitch selvage.

Gauge: 14 sts and 21 rows = 10×10 cm in St st on size 5.5 mm needles.



Back: With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 86 (92, 98) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in St st for 9 rows. Work rows 1 – 12 of elongated st patt. Work in St st until piece meas 27 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape underarm: Cont in St st, inc 1 st at each end of next 4 RS rows = 94 (100, 106) sts. Working a two-stitch selvage at each edge, cont in St st until piece meas 19 (20, 21) cm from last underarm inc row, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders/overarms: Bind off 5 (5, 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 5 (0, 0) sts at beg of next 6 (0, 0) rows, 6 sts at beg of next 4 (10, 6) rows, 0 (0, 7) sts at beg of next 0 (0, 4 rows). Bind off rem 30 sts.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 31 (32, 33) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape V-Neck: Next row (RS): Divide work at center. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 15 times. <u>At same time</u>, when same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder/overarm as foll: At each shoulder edge bind off 5 (5, 6) sts 1 time, 5 (0, 0) sts 3 (0, 0) times, 6 sts 2 (5, 3) times, 0 (0, 7) sts 2 times. No sts rem.

Sleeves: With size 5.5 mm needles cast on 55 (58, 61) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in St st for 9 rows. Work rows 1 – 12 of elongated st patt. Work in St st until piece meas 39 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder/overarm seams. <u>Neckband</u>: With size 5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 97 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. <u>Rnd 1</u>: * K1, yo; rep from * around. <u>Rnd 2</u>: Purl all sts, dropping all yos and pulling sts up to elongate. <u>Rnd 3</u>: * K1, k2tog, sl both sts back to left needle; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2tog. Cut yarn and draw through last st on needle. Sew on sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew all seams 1 st in from each edge.

Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
