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Design 38

PULLOVER



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Size 36 - 42 (44 - 50)

Instructions are given for smaller size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

Materials: 700 (750) g of Lana Grossa **Lala Berlin Tweedy** (33% baby alpaca, 31% polyamide, 30% cotton, 6% Merino wool; 125 m/50 g) in Yellow **(col 9)**. Size 8 and 9 mm needles; size 8 mm circular needle, 50 cm long.

Note: Work with 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.

Selvage stitches: On every row: SI first st kwise, k last st.

Slip stitch selvage: <u>On every row</u>: K first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Rib patt: K2, p2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Garter st: K every row.

Garter stripes A [back and front]: 9 rows St st, 2 rows garter st, 6 rows St st, 6 rows garter st, 22 rows St st, 2 rows garter st, 10 rows St st, 2 rows garter st, 6 rows St st, 2 rows garter st, 6 rows St st, 2 rows garter st, 8 rows St st, 2 rows garter st, 10 rows St st, 2 rows garter st, remainder in St st.

Garter stripes B [sleeves]: [2 rows garter st, 2 rows St st] 4 times, 6 rows garter st, 20 rows St st, [2 rows garter st, 10 rows St st] 2 times, 2 rows garter st, 2 rows St st = 70 rows.

Full-fashion decrease: <u>At beg of RS row</u>, slip st selvage, skp; <u>at end of RS row</u>, work to last 3 sts, k2tog, slip st selvage.

Gauge: 10.5 sts and 18 rows = 10 x 10 cm in garter stripes with size 9 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.


Back: With size 8 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 68 (72) sts. Change to size 9 mm needles. Working first and last st as selvage sts, work in garter stripes A for 35 cm. Place marker at each edge to indicate beg of armholes. Cont in patt until piece meas 24 (25) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 7 (9) sts 1 time, 8 sts 2 times. <u>At same time</u>, when piece meas 1.5 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 20 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 1 st at each neck edge 1 time. No sts rem.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 15 (16) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape V-neck: Next row (RS): Divide work at center. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 11 times and <u>at same time</u>, when piece meas 24 (25) cm from armhole markers, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

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Sleeves: With size 8 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 54 (56) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st (selvage st, * p2, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, selvage st). Cont in rib patt as established until piece meas 4 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 9 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in garter stripes B for 70 rows and piece meas 39 cm from end of rib patt. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. <u>Neckband</u>: With size 8 mm circular needle and 2 strands held tog, pick up and k 56 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. With 2 sts at bottom V as a 2 knit sts, work rib patt in rnds and work double dec at center V on every alt rnd as foll: Work to 2 sts before center V sts, skp, k2, k2tog. When neckband meas 4 cm from pick-up rnd, loosely bind off all sts in rib. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.




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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
