## JACKET

**Size** 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50) Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

**Materials:** 450 (475, 500, 525) g of Lana Grossa **Cashmere Puro** (100% cashmere; 82 m/25 g) in Light Grey (col 20). Size 5 mm circular needle, 100 cm long.

**St st:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Rev St st:** P on RS, k on WS.

**Two-stitch selvage:** On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

**Full-fashion decrease:** At beg of RS row, selvage st, k2, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, k2tog, k2, selvage st.

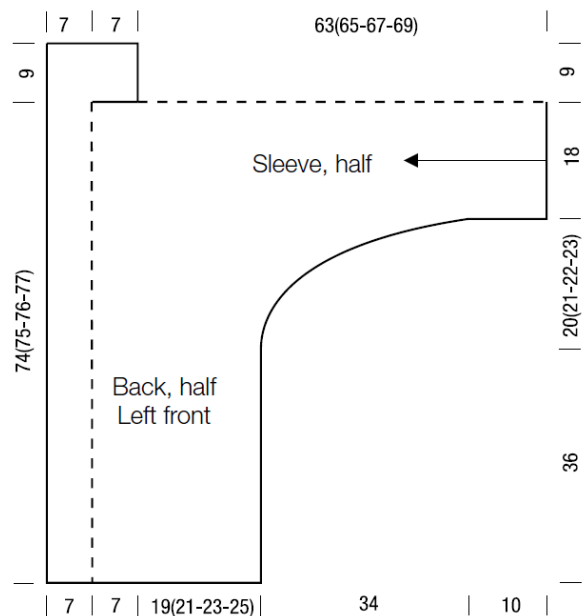
**Full-fashion increase:** On RS row: M1R, 3 sts in from each edge.

**Gauge:** 20 sts and 29 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 5 mm needles.

**Jacket:** Worked side to side and in one piece, beginning at left sleeve. Arrow on schematic shows direction of work. With size 5 mm circular needle cast on 74 sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in St st for 10 cm. Shape sleeve and side edge: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 6th row 4 (3, 2, 1) time(s), then every 4th row 6 (6, 6, 6) times, then every alt row 22 (25, 28, 31) times = 140 (144, 148, 152) sts. Work 1 WS row. Cast on 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 72 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 298 (302, 306, 310) sts. Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage, work next st in rev St st, work in St st to last 3 sts, work next st in rev St st, two-stitch selvage. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 63 (65, 67, 69) cm from sleeve cast-on, ending with a WS row. Divide for back and left front: Next row (RS): Patt over 149 (151, 153, 155) sts and turn, leaving rem sts on hold. **Back:** Work even across back sts for 14 cm, ending with a RS row. Place sts on holder, cut yarn. **Left front:** Return 149 (151, 153, 155) held sts to needles and with RS facing, rejoin yarn. Next row (RS): Cast on 18 sts at beg of row for collar, work to end of row =

167 (169, 171, 173) sts. Work even across collar and left front sts for 14 cm, ending with a WS row. Bind off all sts. Put work aside. **Right front:** With size 5 mm circular needle cast on 167 (169, 171, 173) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in St st for 14 cm. Next row (RS): Bind off 18 sts at beg of row, work to end of row = 149 (151, 153, 155) sts. Next row (WS): Work in patt across 149 (151, 153, 155) right front sts, cont in patt across held 149 (151, 153, 155) back sts = 298 (302, 306, 310) sts. Complete right front and right half of back same as left front and left half of back, reversing all shaping, that is: Bind off sts and work full-fashion decs to shape side edge and sleeve = 74 sts and when right sleeve meas same length as left sleeve, bind off all sts.

**Finishing:** Pin piece to measurements and block. Sew collar seam with mattress st and from WS for the turnback of the collar to the RS. Sew collar to back neck. Sew side and sleeve seams.



## GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
