CASHMERE SPECIAL NO. 1



JACKET

Design 9



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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44) Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 375 (400, 425) g of Lana Grossa **Cashmere Moda** (65% Merino wool, 25% cashmere, 10% polyester; 90 m/25 g) in Light Grey (col 11). Size 6 and 6.5 mm needles; size 6 mm crochet hook.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k8, k2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 11 sts, skp, k8, selvage st.

Full-fashion double decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k2, k3tog; at end of RS row, work to last 6 sts, sk2p, k2, selvage st.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 9 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 18 sts and 24 rows = 10×10 cm in St st on size 6.5 mm needles.

Back: With size 6 mm needles cast on 92 (100, 108) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in St st for 5 rows. Change to size 6.5 mm needles. Cont in St st and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of 12th row from caston, then every 10th row 2 times, then every 8th row 3 times = 80 (88, 96) sts. Work even until piece meas 23 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Work even for another 8 rows, ending with a WS row. Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 8th row 3 times = 88 (96, 104) sts. Work even until piece meas 37 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each end of next 3 (4, 5) RS rows, then every alt RS row 11 (12, 13) times = 28 sts and when piece meas 59 (61, 63) cm from cast-on, bind off all sts.


Left front: With size 6 mm needles cast on 70 (74, 78) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in St st for 5 rows. Change to size 6.5 mm needles. Cont in St st, work decs and incs for side shaping at right edge same as for back. At same time, shape front edge as foll: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at end of 16th row from cast-on, then every 14th row 2 (4, 7) times, then every 12th row 8 (6, 3) times. At same time, when piece meas 37 cm from cast-on, shape raglan at right edge as foll: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next RS row. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at beg of next 1 (2, 3) RS row(s), then every alt RS row 11 (12, 13) times = 31 sts rem for collar. Collar: Work to end of last RS row. Next row (WS): Work to end of row, backloop cast on 1 st [selvage st for seaming] = 32 sts. Cont in patt until collar meas 17 cm from last shoulder bindoff, ending with a WS row. Place sts on holder.


Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping.

Left sleeve: With size 6 mm needles cast on 63 sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work in St st for 5 rows. Change to size 6.5 mm needles. Cont in St st and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of 10th row from cast-on, then every 8th row 3 times, then every 6th row 2 times = 51 sts. Work even until piece meas 18 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Work even for another 6 (6, 4) rows, ending with a WS row. Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 6th row 7 times, then every 4th row 1 time (then every alt 4th and 6th row 4 times, then every 4th row 8 times / then every 4th row 4 times, then every alt 2nd and 4th row 12 times) = 69 (77, 85) sts. Work even until piece meas 41 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at beg of next 3 (4, 5) RS rows, then every alt RS row 11 (12, 13) times. At same time, while working dbl decs at beg of RS rows, work dbl decs at end of RS rows as foll: Dec 2 sts at end of next 2 (2, 3) RS rows, then every alt RS row 11 (12, 13) times. Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 WS rows, 5 sts at beg of next WS row. No sts rem.

Right sleeve: Work same as left sleeve, reversing cap shaping.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams. Graft collar sts tog, then sew collar to back neck edge and top edge of sleeves. With size 6 mm crochet hook, sl st along right front, collar and left front edge.





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GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
