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PULLOVER

Size 36/38 (40/42 - 44/46 - 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Material: Lana Grossa quality "Landlust Winterwolle" (50% Virgin wool (Merino), 35% cotton, 15% yak, RL = approx. 70 m/50 g): approx. 400 (450 - 500 - 550) g mint mottled (col 17); size 7 and 8 knitting needles; 1 size 7 short circular knitting needle

Chain selvage: K 1st st of each row twisted (stitch into the back loop), slip the last st of each row pwise, with the thread in front of the st.

Garter st: RS k, WS k, selv.st. always k

Stockinette stitch: RS k, WS p, always k in rounds

Gauge: St. St. with size 9 needle; 11 sts and 17 rows = 10×10 cm


Right back: Cast on 37 (39 - 41 - 43) sts with size 7 needle and work in garter st for 2 cm between the chain selv. sts, then continue with size 9 needle between the chain selv. sts in St. st. 32 (30 - 28 - 26) cm from the cast on on the right side for the sleeve shape cast on 6 x 5 sts on every 2nd row = 67 (69 - 71 - 73) sts. for 14 (16 - 18 - 20) cm cont. work over all sts, then cast off all sts

Left back: Work in the opposite direction to the right back.

Left front: Work like the right back, but for the neckline, cast off 9 sts on the left side 46 cm from the cast on, then cast off 1 \times 3 sts and 1 \times 1 st on every other row.

Right front: Work in the opposite direction to the left front

Finishing: Sew the side and bottom sleeve seams. Sew the shoulder and upper sleeve seams so that the seams face outwards. Likewise, close the front and back center, leaving a 7 cm slit open at the hem. For the neck, pick up 60 sts with size 7 circular knitting needle and work in St. st in a 2.5 cm round, then loosely bind off all sts



GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
