Design 17

JACKET



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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50) Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 450 (450, 500, 500) g of Lana Grossa Alpaca Moda (74% baby alpaca, 13% Merino wool; 13% polyamide; 135 m/50 g) in Charcoal (col 5). Size 4 and 7 mm needles; size 4 mm circular needle, 40 cm long; six 25 mm snap buttons in dark grey.

Rib patt: Row 1 (RS): K1, p1 across row. Row 2 (WS): Work sts as they appear. Row 3 (RS): * Skip next knit st on left needle; insert right needle in row below next purl st on left needle and pull up loop, yo, k2tog tbl; rep from *. Row 4 (WS): * K2tog, p1 across row. Row 5 (RS): As row 1. Row 6 (WS): As row 2. Rep rows 1 – 6.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Slip st rib: Row 1 (RS): K1, p1 across row. All foll rows: Knit all knit sts, sl all purl sts pwise wyif.

Gauge: 12 sts and 20 rows = 10×10 cm in St st on size 7 mm needles.

Back: With size 4 mm needles loosely cast on 68 (72, 76, 80) sts. Work in rib patt for 17 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to size 7 mm needles. Work in St st and shape sides as foll: Inc 1 st at each edge every 7 cm 4 times = 76 (80, 84, 88) sts. Work even until piece meas 36 (34, 32, 30) cm from end of rib patt. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont until piece meas 20 (22, 24, 26) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders: At each shoulder edge bind off 4 sts 7 (5, 3, 1) time(s), 5 sts 0 (2, 4, 6) times. Bind off rem 20 sts.

Left front: With size 4 mm needles loosely cast on 39 (41, 43, 45) sts. Next row (RS): Work first 30 (32, 34, 36) sts in rib patt, next 9 sts in slip st rib. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 17 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Work first 30 (32, 34, 36) sts in St st, next 9 sts in slip st rib as established. Work in patt as set by last row for a total of 7 cm, ending with a RS row. Work pocket opening: Next row (WS): Patt over first 26 sts, kf&b in next 4 sts = 34 sts and turn, leaving rem 9 (11, 13, 15) sts on hold. Next row (RS): Work slip st rib over first 7 sts, work St st over next 18 sts, work slip st rib over next 9 sts. Work in patt as set by last row for a total of 18 cm, ending with a RS row. Next row (WS): Patt over 26 sts, p2tog 4 times = 30 sts. Place sts on holder, cut yarn and put work aside. Next, work pocket lining as foll: With size 7 mm needles cast on 22 sts. Work in St st for 7 cm, ending with a RS row. Next row (WS): Work across 22 sts of lining, work across 9 (11, 13, 15) sts left on hold = 31 (33, 35, 37) sts. Next row (RS): Work in St st across these 31 (33, 35, 37) sts and at same time, work first inc for side shaping at right edge = 32 (34, 36, 38) sts. Work rem 3 incs every 7 cm same as for back. Work in St st for a total of 18 cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Work to last 30 sts, then with lining sts held behind and parallel to 30 sts on holder, k2tog each st from holder with its corresponding st on needle, patt to end of row. Cont across all sts until same length as back to armhole. Place armhole

marker at right edge. Cont until piece meas 17 (19, 21, 23) cm from armhole marker, ending with a RS row. Shape neck: Next row (WS): Patt over 9 sts and put on hold, bind off 1 st, patt to end. Bind off 1 st at beg of next 5 WS rows. At same time, when piece meas 3 cm from beg of neck shaping, shape shoulder at right edge as foll: At beg of RS rows bind off 4 sts 7 (5, 3, 1) time(s), 5 sts 0 (2, 4, 6) times. No sts rem.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement.

Sleeves: With size 4 mm needles cast on 42 (46, 50, 54) sts. Work in rib patt for 17 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to size 7 mm needles. Work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 7th row, then every 8th row 4 times = 52 (56, 60, 64) sts. Work even until piece meas 24 cm from end of rib patt, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 8 rows. Bind off rem 20 (24, 28, 32) sts.

Finishing: Sew pocket linings in place on WS. Sew shoulder seams. Collar: With size 4 mm circular needle and RS facing, pick up and k 77 sts along neck edge, including sts on left and right front neck holders. Next row (WS): Work first 9 sts in slip st rib as established, *p1, k1; rep from * to last 10 sts, p1, work last 9 sts in slip st rib as established. Working first 9 sts and last 9 sts in slip st rib as established, work rows 3 – 6 of rib patt, then rep rows 1 – 6 until collar meas 12 cm, ending with a WS row. Working first 9 sts and last 9 sts in slip st rib as established, k1, p1 over rem 77 sts until collar meas 28 cm from pick-up row. Bind off all sts. Fold collar in half to WS and sew down. Sew short edges of collar tog. Sew on snap buttons, with top snap 2 cm down from beg of collar, bottom snap right above rib patt and 3 rem snaps spaced evenly inbetween. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

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GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
