

JACKET



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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50) Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 275 (300, 325, 350) g of Lana Grossa **Silkhair** (70% superkid mohair, 30% silk; 210 m/25 g) in Peach (col 195). Size 4.5 mm needles; long size 4 mm circular needle; four 23 mm mother-of-pearl buttons [by Union Knopf, item 37604, col 12].

Note: Work with 2 strands held tog throughout.

Rib patt: Selvage st, * k1, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, selvage st.

Half-brioche rib: Row 1 (RS): Selvage st, k1, * make a yo, then sl next st pwise, k1; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 2 (WS): Selvage st, * p1, ktog slipped st with its yo; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, selvage st. Rep rows 1 and 2 for half-brioche rib. Note: 1 stitch and 1 yo are treated as 1 stitch.

Full-fashion dbl decrease [armhole at sleeve cap shaping]: At beg of RS row, selvage st, 2 sts in half-brioche rib, sk2p; at end of RS row, work to last 6 sts, k3tog, 2 sts in half-brioche rib, selvage st.

Full-fashion dbl decrease [neck shaping]: At beg of RS row, selvage st, 4 sts in half-brioche rib, sk2p; at end of RS row, work to last 8 sts, k3tog, 4 sts in half-brioche rib, selvage st.

Gauge: 16 sts and 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm in half-brioche rib with size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.

Back: With size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 93 (99, 105, 111) sts. Work in half-brioche rib until piece meas 38 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each end of next 3 (4, 5, 6) RS rows = 81 (83, 85, 87) sts. Cont in patt until armhole meas 20 (22, 24, 26) cm from beg. Bind off all sts.

Left front: With size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 43 (47, 49, 53) sts. Work in half-brioche rib until piece meas 32 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at end of next RS row, then every 12th row 6 times. At same time, when same length as back to armhole, shape armhole at right edge same as for back and when same length as back to shoulder, bind off rem 23 (25, 25, 27) shoulder sts.


Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping.

Sleeves: With size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 45 (51, 57, 63) sts. Work in half-brioche rib and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 2 sts at each end of 17th row from cast-on, then every 18th row 6 times = 73 (79, 85, 91) sts. Cont in patt until piece meas 43 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each

end of next RS row, then every alt RS row 2 (3, 4, 5) times. Work 1 WS row. Bind off rem 61 (63, 65, 67) sts.

Pocket: Make 2. With size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on 21 (23, 25, 27) sts. Work in half-brioche rib for 12 (13, 14, 15) cm. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Sew pockets to center of fronts and 1 cm up from cast-on edge. Sew shoulder seams. Front and neckband: With size 4 mm circular needle and 2 strands held tog pick up and k 116 (120, 124, 128) sts evenly along right front, 35 (33, 35, 33) sts along back neck and 116 (120, 124, 128) sts along left front edge = 267 (273, 283, 289) sts. Work in rib patt for 1.5 cm, ending with a WS row. Next RS (buttonhole) row: Work 22 sts in rib patt, [bind off 2 sts, work 12 sts in rib patt] 3 times, bind off 2 sts, work in rib patt to end. On foll WS row, cast on 2 sts over each set of bound-off sts. Cont in rib patt until band meas 3.5 cm from pick-up row. Bind off all sts. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.



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GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
