



Design 05 – Classici 26

CARDIGAN PROMESSA

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: **350 (400, 450) g** of Lana Grossa **Promessa** (70% organic cotton, 30% recycled polyamide; 125 m/50 g) in **Pink (col 5)** and **250 (300, 350) g** in **Orange (col 4)**. Size 5 and 7 mm needles; size 5 mm circular needle, 100 cm long.

Rib patt: P2, k2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Stripe patt A [back and fronts]: Work 10 rows in Pink, then work [19 rows in Orange, 19 rows in Pink] 3 times = 114 rows, work remainder in Orange.

Stripe patt B [sleeves]: Work 10 rows in Pink, then work [19 rows in Orange, 19 rows in Pink] 1 time = 38 rows, work remainder in Orange.

Selvage sts: On every row: Knit first and last st.

Slip stitch selvage: On RS row, ktbl first st, sl last st pwise wyib; on WS row, ptbl first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k2, k2tog; at end of RS row, work to last 5 sts, skp, k2, selvage st.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 3 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 18 sts and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 7 mm needles.

Back: With size 5 mm needles and Pink cast on 118 (122, 126) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as set by last row for a total of 11 rows, increasing 0 (2, 4) sts evenly on last WS row = 118 (124, 130) sts. Change to size 7 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and work stripe patt A. When piece meas 35 cm from cast-on, place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont until piece meas 24 (25, 26) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 6 sts 4 times, 7 sts 2 times (6 sts 1 time, 7 sts 5 times / 7 sts 4 times, 8 sts 2 times). At same time, when piece meas 3 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 24 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 6 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 3 sts 1 time. No sts rem.

Left front: With size 5 mm needles and Pink cast on 55 (55, 59) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p2, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as set by last row for a total of 11 rows, increasing 0 (3, 2) sts evenly on last WS row = 55 (58, 61) sts. Change to size 7 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and work stripe patt A. When piece meas 32 (33, 34) cm from cast-on, shape neck as foll: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at end of next RS row, then every alt RS row 12 times, then every 6th row 4 times = 38 (41, 44) sts. At same time, when same length as back to armhole, place marker at right edge and when same length as back to shoulder, shape shoulder at right edge same as for back. No sts rem.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping.

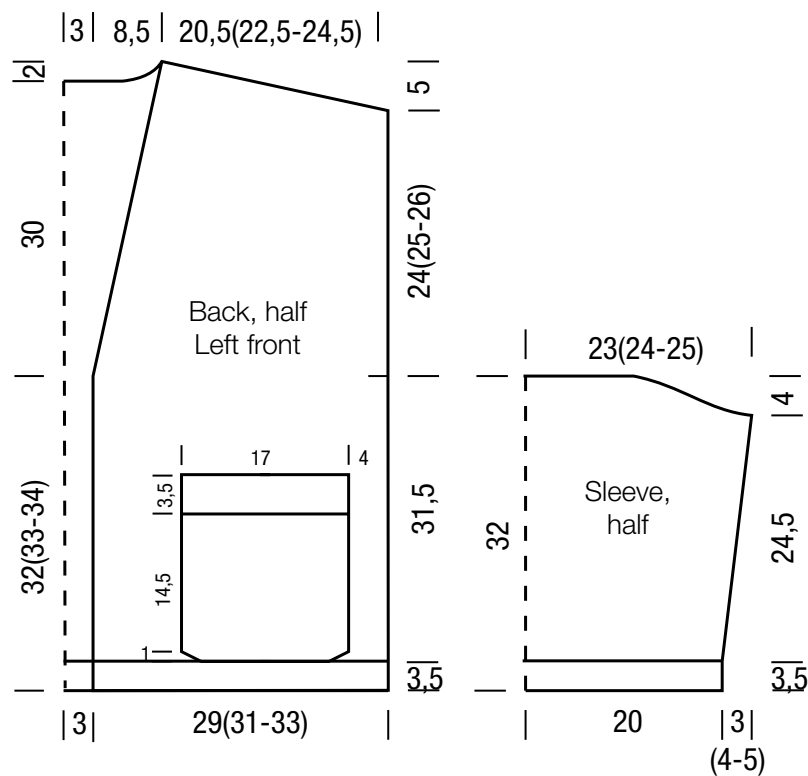
Sleeves: With size 5 mm needles cast on 74 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as set by last row for a total of 11 rows. Change to size 7 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and stripe patt B and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 11 (9, 7)th row, then every 10th row 4 times (then every 8th row 5 times, then every 6th row 1 time / then every 6th row 8 times) = 84 (88, 92) sts. Work even until piece meas 28 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off rem 44 (48, 52) sts.

Pockets: Make 2. With size 7 mm needles and Pink cast on 30 sts. Beg with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in St st for 37 rows and working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of first RS row = 32 sts. Work 9 rows in Pink, 19 rows in Orange, 9 rows in Pink = 37 rows. Change to size 5 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, k2, selvage st. Work in rib patt a set by last row for a total of 9 rows. Bind off all sts in rib.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. **Front and neckband:** With size 5 mm circular needle and Pink, pick up and k 67 (71, 75) sts along straight edge and 60 sts along shaped edge of right front, 46 sts along back neck, 60 sts along shaped edge and 67 (71, 75) sts along straight edge of left front = 300 (308, 316) sts. Next row (WS): Slip st selvage, p2, * k2, p2; rep from *, end slip st selvage. Work in rib patt as set by last row until band meas 6 cm. Bind off all sts in rib. Referring to schematic for placement, sew pockets to fronts. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

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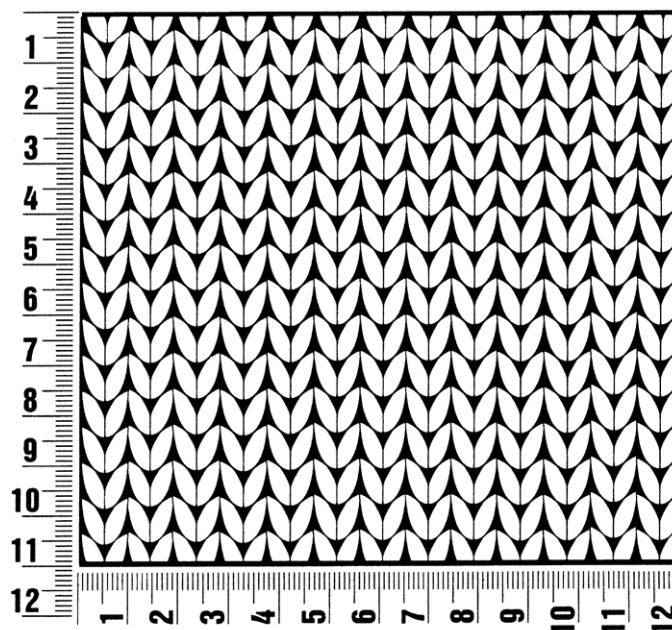
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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvedge stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
