Design 22 – Lookbook 20



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 (400, 450, 450) g of Lana Grossa **Bottoni** (53% cotton, 24% viscose, 23% superfine Merino wool; 125 m/50 g) in Citrus Yellow/Cream (**col 19**). Size 3.5 and 4.5 mm needles; short size 3 mm circular needle.

Rib patt: RS row: *K2, p2*, rep *-*, end k2. On foll rows work sts as they appear.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 2 sts in from each edge.

Full-fashion decrease: At beg of RS row, k2, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

Gauge: 19 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 4.5 mm needles.

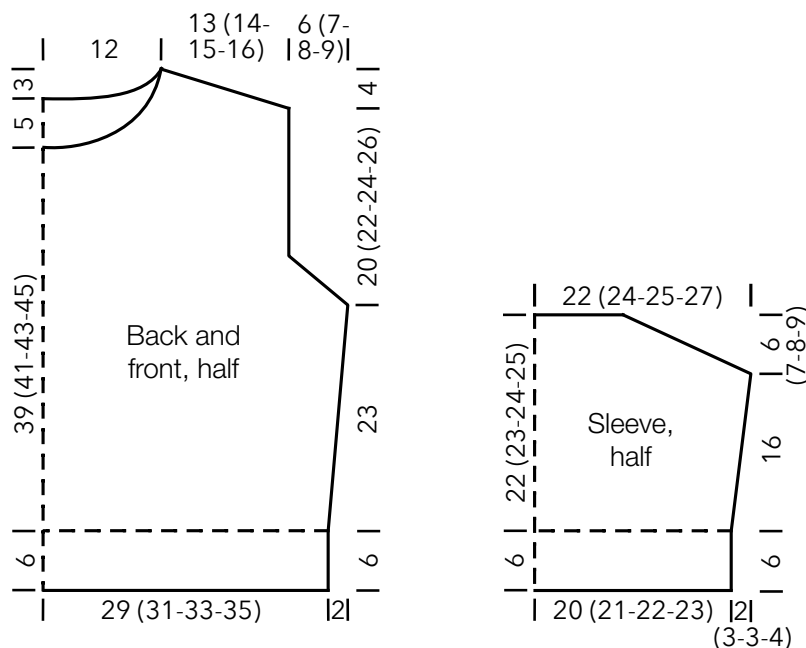
Back: Using size 3.5 mm needles cast on 110 (118, 126, 134) sts. Beginning with a RS row, work in rib patt until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 4.5 mm needles. Work in St st for 13 rows, ending with a WS row. Shape sides: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 14th row 3 times = 118 (126, 134, 142) sts. Work even until piece meas 23 cm from end of rib patt, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows = 100 (108, 116, 124) sts. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 3 (5, 7, 9) RS

rows = 94 (98, 102, 106) sts. Work even until armhole meas 20 (22, 24, 26) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 4 sts 5 times, 5 sts 1 time (4 sts 3 times, 5 sts 3 times / 4 sts 1 time, 5 sts 5 times / 5 sts 5 times, 6 sts 1 time). **At same time**, when working 3rd RS shoulder bind-off row, shape neck: Bind off center 32 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 1 time, 1 st 1 time. No sts rem.

Front: Work same as back until armhole meas 16 (18, 20, 22) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 14 sts = 40 (42, 44, 46) sts rem each side. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 6 times. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 3 times and **at same time**, when armhole meas 20 (22, 24, 26) cm, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

Sleeves: Using size 3.5 mm needles cast on 78 (82, 86, 90) sts. Beginning with a RS row, work in rib patt until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 4.5 mm needles. Work in St st for 6 (4, 4, 2) rows, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 8th row 3 times (then every alt 8th and 6th row 4 times / then every 6th row 5 times / then every alt 6th and 4th row 6 times) = 86 (92, 98, 104) sts. Work even until piece meas 16 cm from end of rib patt, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 14 (16, 18, 20) rows. Bind off rem 36 sts.

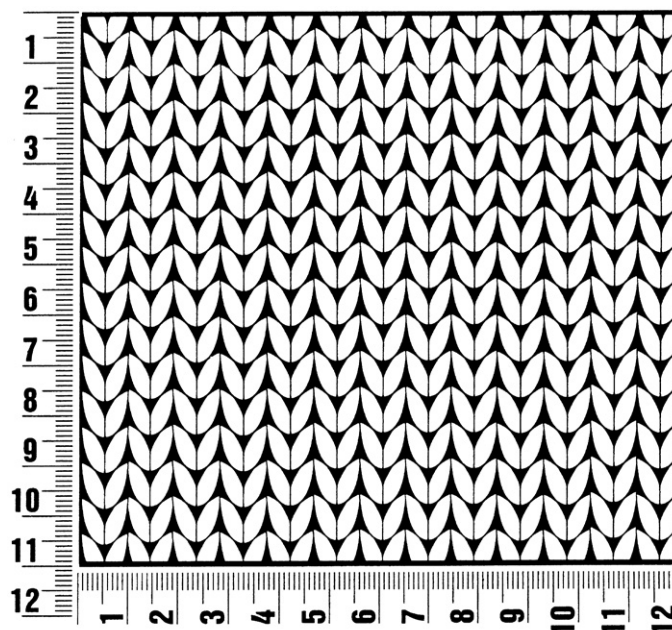
Finishing: Sew shoulder seams. **Neckband:** Using size 3 mm circular needle, pick up and k 108 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. *K2, p2*, rep *-* around until band meas 4 cm. Bind off all sts. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
